Dear FOIA Manager,

This request is made under the federal FOIA Act, 5 U.S.C. 552.

Air Force Times is request the investigation report of the July 1, 2002 incident in Afghanistan in which an Air Force AC-130 fired on an Afghan village in response to reported anti-aircraft fire. The AC-130 attack was investigated after local Afghans claimed the gunship actually fired on a wedding party. Heading the investigation was Air Force Brig. Gen. Przbyslawski.

Air Force Time had earlier submitted a request for this report [FOIA 03-005] and was requested to resubmit a request. This is the resubmittal of that request.

As you know, the FOI Act provides that if portions of a document are exempt from release, the remainder must be segregated and disclosed. Therefore, I will expect you to send me all nonexempt portions of the records that I have requested, and ask that you justify any deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the FOI Act. I reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any materials.

Because information from this report will be published in Air Force Times and distributed worldwide to the Air Force community we request than duplication and handling fees be waived.
