

1. NAME OF RECIPIENT: (b)(6)
2. DATE OF INCIDENT OR DAMAGE: 01 Jan 05
3. LOCATION OF INCIDENT OR DAMAGE: (b)(2)High
4. DESCRIPTION: The claimant reports that his uncle was shot and killed by a coalition forces patrol while traveling on (b)(2)High. Hand signals and warning shots were used in the escalation of ROE, but the vehicle continued to move toward the patrol. Due to the speed of the oncoming vehicle, several shots entered the windshield, striking the driver. Subsequently, the victim died of the wounds received.
5. JUSTIFICATION: By making this condolence payment, MNF ensures the family and community recognize the MNFs' sympathy for the unfortunate loss. Support will positively influence both the community and local Iraqi leaders.

SUBJECT: Condolence Payment (Death)

1. NAME OF RECIPIENTS: (b)(6)
2. DATE OF INCIDENT: 1 January 2005
3. LOCATION:
4. DESCRIPTION: Approximately 1500 hrs on the first of January (b)(6) was traveling west on (b)(2)High in the vicinity MB 160 917. A Co 1088th (Gator element) was acting as security for the (b)(2)High (b)(6) vehicle was observed moving at a high rate of speed toward the lead element of the security element. Hand signals, warning shots, and disabling shots were all used in the escalation of the ROE, but the vehicle continued to move toward the (b)(2)High security element. Deadly force was used as a last resort. Once the vehicle had stopped and been determined not to be a VBIED a medic was called up but the driver was already dead. While TF Steel was not involved in the accident, (b)(6) is the (b)(6) of an (b)(6) member and the (b)(6) is in Steel's AO. This is the most cooperative (b)(6) in the Baghdad area and any assistance given would build on an already favorable relationship in this area.
