SUBJECT: AR 15-6 Investigation Concerning the Indirect Fire Mission on 27 AUG 07 that Resulted in the Death of a Non-Combatant Near Koshtowz, Afghanistan

1. BLUF: I find that the use of 120mm mortar fires at OP Warheit on 27 August 2007 was a lawful use of force against a positively identified threat. I find that two local national non-combatants were in the vicinity of the contact as a result of the deliberate efforts of the enemy to lure them into harm's way. The non-combatants were not visible to the observers at OP Warheit. The indirect fires on the enemy one local national juvenile (female) was killed and her father was wounded.
2. RECOMMENDATION: That CJTF-82 should disseminate to Commanders the Enemy TTP of spreading reports of dead livestock to local villagers in order to lure them to sights of future attacks. Commanders can then pass this information along to Elders and they can come up with systems in their Areas of Operation to prevent the enemy from replicating the same effects.

MEMORANDUM FOR COL (b)(3), (b)(6) CJTF-82 Chief of Staff

SUBJECT: AR 15-6 Investigation Concerning the Indirect Fire Mission on 27 AUG 07 that Resulted in the Death of a Non-Combatant Near Koshtowz, Afghanistan

1. On 05 September 2007, I was appointed as the AR 15-6 Investigating Officer (IO) for the indirect fire mission on 27 August 2007 that resulted in the death of (b)(6) a non-combatant female minor from the village of Kamdesh. I have conducted a thorough investigation of the circumstances surrounding this accident. My observations, conclusions, and recommendations are provided in the following format: facts, findings, and recommendations.

2. FACTS. On 27 August 2007, PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) while pulling guard duty on OP WARHEIT (b)(2)High spotted personnel near the abandoned village of Koshtowz (b)(2)High (b)(2)High while using a (b)(2)High OP WARHEIT had been attacked from that same location the day prior by enemy wearing the same uniform as those 4-5 individuals then in the area. PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) notified his Squad Leader, SSG (b)(3), (b)(6) and the Forward Observer at WARHEIT, SPC (b)(3), (b)(6) (b)(3), (b)(6), of the sighting and the three of them positively identified the individuals at (b)(2)High (b)(2)High as being armed and digging in. They also did not see any non-combatants in the area, or any indicators (b)(1)1.4a ) that would suggest non-combatants were present. SFC (b)(3), (b)(6) NCOIC of OP WARHEIT obtained permission to fire the 120 MM Mortar on OP WARHEIT at the enemy combatants at approximately 0700z from CPT (b)(3), (b)(6) B TRP 1-91 CAV Commander. The mortar crew fired 10 rounds of HE and 1 of WP and the rounds were observed hitting within 10 meters of the enemy by SPC (b)(3), (b)(6) wounding 4 of them. (b)(1)1.4a

a. The village of Koshtowz is one that has been long-abandoned due to a past tribal feud. The only remaining structures are foundations of old buildings and the area is mined. None of the witnesses that were interviewed by the IO had ever seen livestock or non-combatants in the area (b)(2)High

b. At 1100Z (b)(6) an interpreter at WARHEIT, informed SFC (b)(3), (b)(6) that a non-combatant had been reported killed by the indirect fire. No one on OP WARHEIT had

seen any non-combatants in the vicinity of the fire mission before, during, or after the engagement. No coalition member ever saw the remains of the dead girl or her father, who locals reported was wounded by the indirect fire. SFC (b)(3), (b)(6) relayed to CPT (b)(3), (b)(6) what the interpreter and local nationals who live near OP WARHEIT reported to him and CPT (b)(3), (b)(6) reported the information to TF SABER TOC at 271500ZAUG07. [EXHIBIT D-E]

c. Having no physical evidence or visual confirmation that one non-combatant was killed due to the indirect fire and another was wounded (b)(6), CPT (b)(3), (b)(6) and SFC (b)(3), (b)(6) had to establish the facts by interviewing elders from Kamdesh Village. One of these elders is the Mullah for the mosque located in Camp Keating, who is related to the injured man and the deceased girl. He informed CPT (b)(3), (b)(6) that (b)(3), (b)(6) had been informed that some of his cows were killed by indirect fire during the TIC on 26 AUG and had gone to the area with his daughter to salvage some of the meat before it spoiled. The Mullah claims that the girl was killed, and the father was wounded, by shrapnel from the indirect fire attack. The elders of Kamdesh believe that the enemy combatants spread the story about the cows to draw non-combatants to the area of the 26 AUG TIC so that they could be placed in danger when the enemy initiated contact on OP WARHEIT on 27 AUG. [EXHIBIT E]

d. Based on the positive relationship that B TRP has with the Kamdesh Elders, especially with the Mullah who works on FOB KEATING, CPT (b)(3), (b)(6) decided to believe their report that (b)(6) was killed during the indirect fire attack from OP WARHEIT on 27 AUG 07. Once it was concluded that a death to a non-combatant due to 1-91 Cavalry Operations had occurred, the Squadron submitted an official Serious Incident Report on 020935ZSEP07 and assigned an Investigating Officer to Conduct a 15-6 Investigation.

e. Due to the fact that the indirect fire had been approved by CPT (b)(3), (b)(6), the original IO, 1LT (b)(3), (b)(6) was disqualified from conducting the investigation because he was outranked by someone involved in the accident. After receiving my appointment as the IO, I received my inbrief from MAJ (b)(3), (b)(6) on 06 SEP telephonically and then read RC EAST FRAGO 277 to OPOD 06-06 (Revised EOF Procedures) [ENCLOSURE III], ISAF TACTICAL DIRECTIVE 28 JUN 07 [ENCLOSURE IV], RC EAST FRAGO 509 to OPOD 04-05 (Employment of Joint Fires) [ENCLOSURE V], CENTCOM Guidance for U.S. Forces Operating in Afghanistan 04 AUG 07 [ENCLOSURE VI] in order to clarify what the current ROE is for employment of indirect fires. I took the next available flight out to B TRP's AO on 19 SEP and collected the Sworn Statements from the previous IO. After reading through the Statements of SFC (b)(3), (b)(6) SSG (b)(3), (b)(6) and SPC (b)(3), (b)(6) reinterviewed them and had them re-swear to the truth of the statements. I then interviewed PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) and CPT (b)(3), (b)(6) and had them fill out sworn statements. I

remained at FOB Keating until 13 SEP 07 due to lack of available aircraft and then returned to FOB Naray. While I was in the Kamdesh area, there were two incidents where Local villagers became involved in small-arms battles with enemy combatants. These incidents, combined with the atmospherics of the area, indicate that the Coalition forces operating out of FOB Keating and OP WARHEIT maintain the support of the Afghan People in the area.

## 3. FINDINGS:

a. I find that the B TRP indirect fire engagement in the vicinity of OP WARHEIT on 27 AUG 07 falls under the Self Defense (Troops In Contact) category [ENCLOSURE III, line 3.D.8.J]. OP WARHEIT had been engaged by RPG from vicinity (b)(2)High by enemy personnel the previous day so that, when armed personnel appeared in the same vicinity in the same uniform the next day, any reasonable person would realize that they were about to be attacked again. By using indirect fire on the enemy combatants in a timely manner, the B TRP Soldiers saved themselves from having to endure incoming rounds.

b. I find that the B TRP Soldiers on OP WARHEIT complied with RC EAST FRAGO 509 to OPOD 07-03 COMSEF TACTICAL DIRECTIVE ON EMPLOYMENT OF JOINT FIRES 230745ZJUL07 [ENCLSOURE III] for Troops In Contact. TIC situations require PID and Adherence to LOAC. The B TRP Soldiers had a reasonable certainty; through the use of (b)(2)High, (b) binoculars, and a spotting scope; that the target being fired upon was a legitimate Military Target and so had Positive Identification (PID) through the entire engagement. The engagement also complies with the fundamental LOAC principles of Military Necessity, Proportionality, and Distinction. The presence of armed personnel in enemy uniforms at the sight of a previous attack made it a military necessity to prevent those personnel from initiating an engagement. The use of only 10 rounds of HE mortar and 1 of WP in the cave infested terrain is enough to ensure that the enemy would not be able to survive the initial burst, hide from subsequent rounds, and return later to engage friendly personnel on OP WARHEIT. No non-Enemy personnel were identified before, during, or after the indirect fire engagement and The Patterns Of Life (POL) for the abandoned Koshtowz Village area indicated that it was completely free of non-combatant presence, making the collateral damage risk extremely low. The B TRP Soldiers on OP WARHEIT reacted to the threat posed by enemy combatants exactly as they should have.

c. I find that the actions of B TRP during the month of August, specifically on 26 and 27 AUG 07, are approved of by the local community.

SUBJECT: AR 15-6 Investigation Concerning the Indirect Fire Mission on 27 AUG 07 that Resulted in the Death of a Non-Combatant Near Koshtowz, Afghanistan

a. Due to the fact that B TRP and the Kamdesh Village Elders have a positive working relationship, they should convene a Shura where a plan can be worked out to ensure non-combatants stay out of areas where they normally do not go, and that the enemy routinely use for their activities. At the least, Village Elders should stress to their people that any non-usual activity should be reported to Coalition forces so they can ensure the people stay protected.

b. A Solatia Payment should be made for Bebe Aisha. Such a payment is not admission of wrong-doing, but shows that Coalition forces are sympathetic to the tragedy that has befallen the family of the dead girl caused by the actions of the enemy.

  - f. The identity of any local nationals injured as a result of the fires and the extent and cause of those injuries.
3. This will be an informal AR 15-6 investigation. This will be your primary duty until completed and takes precedence over all other duties and assignments. All statements will be in written form and sworn, using DA Form 2823. If witnesses have redeployed, seek to conduct telephonic interviews of them at their home station.
4. If, during the course of the investigation, you suspect that anyone involved has violated any criminal laws, you should advise that person of their Article 31 Rights, prior to questioning. It was possible those could have been RPG's. One other guy had a shovel and was digging. I then informed SSG (b)(3), (b)(6), we all agreed they were getting ready for another attack. At 1430 hrs I, SSG(3), (b) went up to the (b)(2)High where PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) was scanning the area where it came from, which was (b)(2)High I continued to observe with the (b)(2)High to confirm PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) spot reports, which was 15-20 ACM armed with AK-47's and RPG's. Once the enemy was positively identified by PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) and myself we started to engage the enemy with the 240B, M249 and the MK 19 to fix and destroy the enemy. At approx. 1500 hrs we received support by A10's Aircraft who scanned the area and identified ACM moving towards south. due to procedures of the 9 line for authorization for the pilots to engage, the A10 lost visual on the enemy.

On 27 August 2007 at 0700 hrs, SPC (b)(3), (b)(6) called me outside the TOC to inform me that PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) spotted 4-5 personnel, dressed in green uniforms, with AK-47's in the same area (b)(2)High where we received the attack just one day prior. After I, SSG (3), (b)(6) and SPC (b)(3), (b)(6) confirmed that initial report given by PFC (b)(3), (b)(6) I sent the report to higher and requested a fire mission for the 120mm Mortar system. Once approved by Bulldawg TOC, we engaged with 10 HE and 1 WP mortar. The rounds were observed and fire mission was completed within 20 minutes. At approx. 1100 hrs (b)(6) the Interpreter at Warheit reported that a little girl was killed from our engagement. He stated that the girl was with her father at the site to collect the cattle meat from the cattle that died the day prior due to our fire mission. On 27 August 2007, due to the Indirect Fires (IDF) from OP Warheit fired in response to enemy contact, a Kamdesh Non-Combatant female, Bebe Aisha, (father - (b)(6) was killed. The enemy had been aggressively patrolling in the area two weeks prior to the incident, including the night of 26 August 2007 when enemy fired direct and indirect fire accurately into OP Warheit from (b)(2)High. The next day, 270700AUG2007, enemy were spotted again wearing ANA style BDUs at the same grid and CF at OP Warheit returned fire with 10 rounds of 120mm HE mortars. They used binoculars, spotting scopes, and the (b)(2)High to observe, acquire, and engaged positively identified targets effectively and accurately with indirect fires. I, CPT(b)(3), (b)(6) B Trp Commander, cleared the fires and gave the command to fire the mission. Later that day, SFC (3), (b) NCOIC at OP Warheit, was informed by the Kamdesh elders of the death of the local national child and an injury to her father. SFC(3), (b)(3), (b) was also informed of the emerging enemy Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures (TTPs) of utilizing livestock and Non-Combatants as a disguise to cover their movement during both daytime and hours of limited visibility. The enemy TTP masks their movement and intent as they position themselves for Observation Posts (OPs) and fighting positions utilized to attack CF/ANSF in the Kamdesh area. The enemy is aware of (b)(2)High and now has initiated this new TTP in order to enhance their freedom of maneuver with the purpose of staging attacks on CF/ANSF. SFC(3), (b) notified me of the death at approximately 1500z and I relayed the message to Saber TOC.

The enemy actions against Camp Keating and OP Warheit in August have resulted in 1 ANA KIA, 1 US WIA, and 2 ANA WIA as well as damage to CF/ANSF facilities. Bulldawg Troop's responses to these attacks have been CAS, IDF, and Force Protection measures that have reportedly resulted in considerable degradation to enemy fighter strength and capabilities. The success of Bulldawg in suppressing the enemy is directly correlated with accurate and immense use of (b)(2)High. The death of this Non-Combatant was collateral damage that directly resulted from enemy actions which put her in harm's way. The enemy is undoubtedly responsible for the violence which led to the death of the Non-Combatant and the attacks on OP Warheit and Camp Keating. SFC(3), (b) and I have spoken to the village elders and the Mullah at Camp Keating (b)(6) on three different occasions. We've expressed our condolences and asked why the girl was in that area. The elders stated that the girl and her father had been told that 14 of their cows had been killed due to the IDF on 26 August 2007. They had gone there to attempt to salvage meat from the dead cows. The child's family and local shuras have expressed their understanding of the situation. They do not blame the CF/ANSF for this unfortunate event. They're infuriated with the enemy and know that this is a tactic that they use to knowingly put them in harm's way for their own purposes. The family of the Non-Combatant child who was killed has not been vengeful or threatening in any manner, further showing their understanding of the enemy situation and the measures taken by CF/ANSF in order to protect their well being as well as that of the entire local populace in AO Bulldawg. The Kamdesh village has been supportive of the CF/ANSF and has not mentioned any compensation for the child or the cows. I feel the US should offer Solatia funds to the family for the child at a minimum. We will continue to work on keeping a good working relationship with the Kamdesh elders for the future of Afghanistan. The offering of Solatia funds would greatly enhance that effort.




  - a. The facts and circumstances surrounding the indirect fire mission on 27 August 2007 near Koshtowz, Afghanistan;
  - b. The intended targets at the time of the fire mission;
  - c. Whether the fire mission was fired in self defense or whether the fire mission was an offensive use of force;
  - d. If the fire mission was an offensive use of force, whether any ISAF required approvals were obtained to authorize the fires;
  - e. Whether the mission complied with the applicable Rules of Engagement; and
  - f. The identity of any local nationals injured as a result of the fires and the extent and cause of those injuries.
3. This will be an informal AR 15-6 investigation. This will be your primary duty until completed and takes precedence over all other duties and assignments. All statements will be in written form and sworn, using DA Form 2823. If witnesses have redeployed, seek to conduct telephonic interviews of them at their home station.
4. If, during the course of the investigation, you suspect that anyone involved has violated any criminal laws, you should advise that person of their Article 31 Rights, prior to questioning. If anyone attempts to interfere with or obstruct your investigation, notify the appointing authority immediately.

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: AR 15-6 Investigation into the indirect fire mission on 27 August 2007 that resulted in the death of a local national near Koshtowz, Afghanistan

1. I have reviewed the AR 15-6 investigation into the indirect fire (IDF) mission that occurred on 27 August 2007. The investigating officer (IO) found that the members of B Troop, 1st Squadron, 91st Cavalry Regiment acted in self-defense when they executed the IDF mission on 27 August 2007 and that their actions complied with current Rules of Engagement and Directives. The reports that a non-combatant was killed by the indirect fire could only be verified from the verbal accounts given by local villagers. No visible authentication of a death was made and no civilians were observed in the area at the time of the engagement.
2. I approve the IO's findings and recommendations with the following exception and substitution: the recommendations to conduct a Shura with the local village elders and to make a solatia payment to the family of the deceased local national are returned to the unit for appropriate action.
3. The IO's report contains evidence that enemy personnel used unlawful tactics to lure local villagers to the engagement area where they could be injured or killed. This demonstrates the enemy's continued disregard for the safety of the people of Afghanistan. Regardless of the enemy's attempts to cause harm and injury to innocent civilians, OEF and ISAF forces will continue to train on applicable Rules of Engagement and make every effort to minimize any damage or injury to the civilian population of Afghanistan.
4. The investigation is returned to the unit for appropriate action consistent with the Investigating Officer's findings and recommendations and my additional instructions above.
