You have submitted a claim seeking compensation for your loss. I have thoroughly reviewed your claim pursuant to the Foreign Claims Act (FCA), Title 10, United States Code §2734, Army Regulation 27-20, and Department of the Army Pamphlet 27-162 Claims Procedures.
