EOF	A Co, 1-23 IN	24-Mar-07	While returning back to Camp Liberty from a mission Apache Company took fire from the direction of a Mosque in the vicinity. Unit returned fire in direction of the mosque with two TOW missiles.	(b)(2)(H)ig	Investigation in for legal review 10 Apr 07		
EOF	B Co, 5-20 IN	27-Mar-07	At 270435 (b)(2)(H)ig reported that B/5-20 was engaged by IDF in the Khatoon neighborhood, in the Diyala Province at B/5-20 reported being engaged by 1x rd of IDF, most likely direct lay 60mm.. B/5-20 engaged 1x AIF in an alleyway to the west of their position with negative effects. 0400: AWT and UAV on station conduct recon of area. 0500: UAV identified several vans in the area and focused on 1x dismounted unarmed person who appeared to be observing the B/5-20 element. 0530: escalation of force against 1x LN driving a van toward their location at a high rate of speed. The LN suffered from 2x GSW to the leg and 1x GSW to the buttock. Elements of 3/B/5-20 dismounted from their vehicles in an attempt to interdict a second van approx 200m west of RTE. 4x US casualties were sustained during this engagement and were all ground evacuated non-standard to FOB Warhorse. 2x CAS were later air evacuated to Balad for higher level care. Green on Blue incident	HHC, 1-23 IN	4-Apr-07	On 040307APR07, IA at a permanent TCP at the intersecti Snake and Cardinals fired a burst of small arms fire at Team 3/Recon/HHC/1-23 IN striking a (b)(3) in the right calf. (b)(3) was MEDEVAC to the 28th CSH in the green zone immediately. Initial questioning at the TCP yielded (b)(3) that they didn't shoot and that it must have been the Wahhabis. Interviews from Team 3 indicated they were engaged from the TCP. The unit at the TCP were reported as 2/2/5-1-6 IA under the command of (b)(3) 1-23 IN did not do direct liaison with the IA on the ground before commencing operations. Friend (b)(3) marked with Phoenix beacons. Team 3 identified the location of the TCP during operations and knew its composition.	(b)(3)	Investigation in for legal review 14 Apr 07		
Negligent Discharge	B Co, 1-23	6-Apr-07	While in his CHU on Pad 7 Camp Liberty (b)(3) had a negligent discharge of a 9mm pistol (b)(3) a minor abrasion to his left hand and exited out the back of the CHU and hit a barrier. (b)(3) had borrowed the weapon from another Soldier to go to the PX. (b)(3) was alone in his CHU at the time of the incident and claimed to have been clearing the weapon. Negligent Discharge	A Co, 2-3 IN	14-Apr-07	AT APPROXIMATELY 1830 ON 14 AUG 2007, UPON EXITING THE REAR OF THE STRYKER DISCHARGED HIS M-4 RIFLE INTO THE GROUND. AS HE EXITED THE VEHICLE, HE TRIP STEPPING OFF THE RAMP AND FELL ALMOST COMPLETELY TO THE GROUND. AS HE MOVED TO CATCH HIMSELF, HE MOVED HIS SELECTOR SWITCH FROM SAFE TO SEMI AND DEPRESSED THE TRIGGER. A ROUND DISCHARGED OUT OF THE RIFLE AND ENTERED THE DIRT WITHOUT HARMING ANYONE.
