(a) Date of Incident: 30 March 2006

(b) Unit: A Co., 14th EN BN

(c) Brief Description: On 30 March 2006 2125, A Co., conducted an EOF on a BMW 525i, along with RTE Volvo. The vehicle was moving from north to south, and proper EOF procedures were conducted. The gunner of the lead vehicle, RG-31, shouted, flashed the spot light, shined the green beam prior to firing his weapon. The gunner fired one wa [redacted] shot with his M16 into the shoulder of the road when the vehicle was at approx [redacted] meters distance and the vehicle did not show any sign of slowing down. The [redacted] ner engaged the vehicle's engine block, the vehicle seemed to slow down then suddenly sped up again turned head on towards the lead vehicle. At this point, the gunner engaged the vehicle cabin. The vehicle veered right and rolled to a stop hitting the curb. The driver was administered first aid by the platoon medic until the he was tak [redacted] where he was pronounced dead.



(c) Brief Description: After being fired upon at their observation post, a B/1-36 IN Observation Post team observed a man (Local National) on a motorcycle move into their area, move out of line of sight of their OP, and then stop along a nearby road. The two-man dismount team moved to regain visual contact with the man. Upon arriving within shouting distance of the man (LN), the team observed him digging by the side of the road. The team leader then shouted to the man to stop what he was doing, showed him his weapon, and at that time, the man responded by quickly moving his hands toward his hips. The Soldier took this action as hostile intent and escalated to deadly force and fired at the man killing him.
