

CONDUCT WHILE ON TOUR OF DUTY

- REMAIN IN MARNE STANDARD UNIFORM AT ALL TIMES, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- ABSOLUTELY NO SLEEPING WHILE ON GUARD DUTY.
- NO CELL PHONES WHILE ON GUARD DUTY.
- NO READING MATERIALS WHILE ON DUTY.
- NO WRITING AND OR READING LETTERS WHILE ON DUTY.
- NO IPOD AND OR MUSIC LISTENING DEVICES WHILE ON DUTY.
- CONDUCT A RADIO CHECK EVERY HOUR ON THE HOUR.
- CONDUCT A RADIO CHECK WITH SECONDARY DEVICE EVERY THREE HOURS i.e. (*hand held radio etc.*)
- MAKE SURE WATER IS CONSUMED PRIOR, DURING AND AFTER YOUR TOUR OF DUTY.

*Violation of any of the above instructions is punishable
by article 113 and 134 (Misbehavior of sentinel or lookout)
of the Uniform Code Of Military Justice (UCMJ).*

COMMANDER OF RELIEF CHECK LIST

- MAKE SURE THE GUARD IS IN THE PROPER UNIFORM.
- MAKE SURE THE AREA HAS BEEN PROPERLY POLICED AND FREE OF TRASH.
- MAKE SURE THE 240B IS CLEANED AND LUBRICATED.
- MAKE SURE THERE IS ENOUGH 240B AMMUNITION (800-rnds).
- MAKE SURE COMMUNICATIONS ARE OPERATIONAL (primary & secondary).
- MAKE SURE THERE IS ENOUGH WATER FOR CONSUMPTION .
- MAKE SURE NIGHT VISION GOGGLES AND BINOCULARS ARE PRESENT AND OPERATIONS WITH ADDITIONAL BATTERIES.
- MAKE SURE SECTORS OF FIRES ARE PRESENT AND ACKNOWLEDGE.
- MAKE SURE GUARD IS BRIEFED ON ESCALATION OF FORCE AND ALL GENERAL ORDERS.

No one is more professional than I, I am a non commissioned officer. As a Non Commissioned officer I realize that I am a member of a time honored corps which is known as the back bone of the army.






Position of LNs Body from Tower #5
