- (c) Brief Description: EOF with Death of LN: Routine EOF with warning shots fired in apparently safe direction. After dust cleared from traffic surge and EOF incident, US Soldiers discovered young Iraqi boy roadside vendor dead, most likely hit by traffic surge in the dust cloud. 2 hours later, a family brought another young boy to the IP station with a gunshot wound to the upper back/shoulder. They claimed he was shot on (b)(2) Highway at the cordon, but there is no evidence of it.



(b)(6) ENSE PLATE (b)(6) THE 1 X LN FEMALE ENTERED THE ELEMENTS
PATROL BETWEEN THE 2ND AND 3RD STRYKER IN OOM. RECON/1-17IN FIRED 3 X
WARNING SHOTS INTO THE AIR AND VEHICLE FAILED TO COMPLY. RECON/1-17 THEN
FIRED 1 X WARNING SHOT AT LN's TIRE. THE VEHICLE CONTINUED TO CLOSE ON THE
STRKYERS. RECON FIRED 2 X DISABLING SHOTS AT THE SINGLE PERSON IN THE VEHICLE
RESULTED IN 1 X KIA LN. RECON/1-17IN CONDUCTED SSE AND EXSPRAY OF THE VEHICLE
WITH NEGATIVE RESULT. RECON/1-17 PROVIDED SECURITY FOR THE AMBULANCE.

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- (a) Date of Incident: 10 September 2006
- (b) Unit: B/1-17IN
- (c) Brief Description: EOF with Death of LN. . 2/B/1-17 REPORTED ENGAGING CLOSING ON A DISMOUNTED PATROL IN THE RUSSAFA NEIGHBORHOOD (b)(2)High 2/B WAS CONDUCTING A FLASH TCZ ON AN UN-NAMED ROAD INTERSEC TRAFFIC CIRCLE. STRYKERS WERE USED TO CORDON OFF THE AREA FOCUSING ON THE ROAD TO THE NORTH WEST PORTION OF THE TRAFFIC CIRCLE. THE AIR GUARD ON THE B42 VEHICLE WAS OVERWATCHING THE STOPPED TRAFFIC WHEN A CAR (WHITE 4 DOOR), WITH 1 X LN MALE, DROVE HIS CAR AROUND THE STOPPED TRAFFIC TOWARD THE DISMOUNTED PATROL. THE STRYKER AIR GUARD USED EOF PROCEDURES CONSISTING OF HAND AND ARM SIGNALS, AUDIBLE VOICE AND 1 X WARNING SHOT; THE CAR CONTINUED ON ITS COURSE WITH NO REACTION TO THE WARNINGS. THE DISMOUNTED 2/B PERSONNEL WITNESSED THESE EVENTS (HEARD THE 1 X WARNING SHOT) AND STARTED THE EOF PROCEDURES AGAIN (HAND AND ARM, AUDIBLE VOICE AND 2 X WARNING SHOTS). THE VEHICLE CONTINUED WITH NO REGARD TO THE DISMOUNTED PERSONNEL WARNINGS. 2/B (DISMOUNTED AND MOUNTED) ENGAGED THE VEHICLE WITH DISABLING SHOTS AND LETHAL SHOTS FOLLOWED (ALL 5.56 RND). DISMOUNTED SOLDIERS MADE EYE CONTACT WITH THE LN INDIVIDUAL WHILE GIVING EOF WARNINGS AND DURING DISABLING / LETHAL SHOTS. 1 X LN MALE WAS KIA FROM THE ENGAGEMENT. 2/B SEARCHED THE VEHICLE AND CONDUCTED SSE WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. 2/B LOCATED THE LN's CELL PHONE, BUT IT WAS INOPERABLE. THE SIM CHIP WA (b)(6) N INFORMATION TO CONTACT THE FAMILY. THE NAME OF THE LN (b)(6) DOB (b)(6) FOLLOW UP WITH THE FAMILY WILL BE CO
