(a) Date of Incident: 30 September 2006

(b) Unit: B CO 1-505th IN

(c) Brief Description: At 301145SEP06 1/B/1-505th PIR Combat Outp reported an EOF in the Salah Ad Din province west of Bayji, vic grid (b)(2)High 1/B/1-505th was securing Engineers from A/878 that were reinforcing checkpoint into the COP. Bravo 17 reported that a white Toyota truck approached at a high rate of speed (Est. 50 MPH) along East-West Road. The vehicle sped through both the concertina wire and cones placed approx (b)(2)High from 1/B/1-505th PIR CP. CP attempted to flag vehicle down prior to the ve driving through the cones and wire in front of the COPs location. Vehicle increased speed and both IA and CF engaged with AK-47.M3 and M240. Vehicle veered off the road (b)(2)High from COP location and down into a gully where it caught fire. Small explosions were reported from the truck as it burned. IA from the COP moved the truck to attempt to assess and put out fire. 3 LN reportedly from Tikrit were confirmed dead.

(b) Unit: B Btry, 1-319th ABN FA

(c) Brief Description ately 031155OCT06 a patrol from TF 1-319 executed EOF procedures vic (b)(2)High that resulted in the death of a LN. 3/B/2-505 was task organized to A/1-319 to support OPERATION St. LOUIS. 3/B/2-505 was traveling south in ASR Prune when a civilian vehicle rapidly approached the patrol. EOF measures included audio, visual (VS17), showing weapon (M4), warning shot (M4 to the side of the road), and disabling shots into the radiator. The civilian vehicle did not stop and the

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gunner shot into the vehicle (M4). 3/B/2-505 medical personnel attempted first aid but were unsuccessful to stabilize the LN.

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

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

(2) AR 15-6 Investigation

(a) Date of Incident: 17 September 2006

(b) Unit: A Co., 2-3 IN

(c) Brief Description: TF 2-3 IN reports that 2/1/549th MPs conducted an EOF in the Ninewa Province, Mosul at (b)(2)High on RTE Ford, north of the intersection of RTE Infinity. 2/1/549 MP CO was traveling north on RTE Ford when a LN vehicle approached quickly to the rear. The trail vehicle gunner observed a vehicle with only a driver rapidly approaching at (b)(2)High distance, so he executed hand and arm signals, but the vehicle failed to reduce speed to a stop. At (b)(2)High distance, the gunner placed 10-15 rounds of 7.62mm from a M240 into the hood of the vehicle and through the windshield. The squad continued moving forward to the next available turnaround point, but the civilian vehicle stopped. The vehicle actually contained 1 x LN male, 1 x LN woman, and 1 x LN child. The female and child were located in the backseat, so were not readily visible to the gunner. The male immediately exited the vehicle, and took the child to a local hospital in another civilian vehicle that had stopped at the scene. When the MP squad arrived back on scene, only the LN female was present. They searched the vehicle with no results. The male returned to the scene 20 minutes later and reported the LN child had been pronounced dead at the Abu Nasir Hospital. There was 1 x LN child killed and damage to a civilian vehicle as the result of this incident.

(3) AR 15-6 Investigation

(a) Date of Incident: 26 September 2006

(b) Unit: HHC 5-20 IN

(c) Brief Description: HHC 5-20 IN reports that EOF occurred in the Ninewa Province, Mosul at (b)(2)High on RTE Ford east of the intersection with RTE (b)(2)High. RECON/5-20 IN reported to stop a white pickup truck that was approaching their checkpoint at a high rate of speed. The unit conducted escalation of force measures using hand and arm signals, attempting to stop the vehicle, but the vehicle refused to stop. There was only time to fire 1x round of SAF and it was directed at the driver, hitting him in the chest. RECON/5-20 IN attempted to revive the individual that was suffering from a sucking chest wound but was unable to do so. The vehicle impacted a stryker but caused

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no damage. 2/2/2/ IA took control of the body, transporting it to the Al Jamouri Hospital, while IPs impounded the vehicle. RECON/5-20 IN searched the vehicle, but did not find anything. SIR to follow. There was 1 x LN KIA but no damage as a result of this incident. NFTR.

(a) Date of Incident: 7 October 2006

(b) Unit: 2-37 AR

(c) Brief Description: TF 2-37 AR reports that 3/B/2-37 AR conducted an EOF in the Ninewa Province, Tal Afar at (b)(2)High on ASR Santa Fe northwest of Tal Afar. 3/B/2-37 AR was conducting an individual identified as a woman came walking toward the patrol. The soldiers at the checkpoint motioned for her to stop but she began running toward the M1A2 Abrams. The gunner of the tank fired 3x warning shots in the direction of the individual but she continued to run at the tank. When the woman was approximately (b)(2)High from the tank the gunner engaged her with coax, stopping her advance. 3/B/2-37 positioned their units to ensure that any possible explosives did not injure coalition forces while EOD was dispatched to the scene. Upon further investigation, it was determined that the woman did not have any explosives, and US Forces began immediate treatment. A MEDEVAC was requested and dispatched to the scene. The LN arrived at the 47th CSH at 0600 and was pronounced DOA. SIR to follow. There was 1 x LN KIA but no damage as a result of this incident. NFTR.
