

The moped would not stop heading towards the

patrol despite EOF procedures and the rear vehicle engaged the moped with SAF. This resulted in the death of the moped driver. IPs were on the scene and took the body to Al Jamouri Morgue. IPs searched the body and the bike and found nothing significant to report. There was 1xLN killed and 1x moped with damage as a result of this incident.
