(a) Type of Incident: LN Civilian EOF Fatalities

(b) Date of Incident: 021500DEC06

(c) Unit: D/3-8 Cavalry Regiment, 2d BN, 3BCT, 82 ABN DIV, FOB Brassfield-Mora

(d) Brief Description: At 021500DEC 2006 an escalation of force by a D/3-8 Cav patrol occurred in the Salah Ad Din province, south of Samarra, vicinity (b)(2)High. A black vehicle attempted to pass the patrol. The patrol conducted e rce and then fired warning shots from a M2 .50 cal. The warning shots ricocheted into the vehicle. There were four Iraqi's in the vehicle. The two passengers in the rear of the vehicle (one male & one female) were killed by the shots.

(a) Date of Incident: 2 October 2006

(c) Brief Description: At 021758OCT2006, an IED detonation was reported by 3-82 in the SALAH AD DIN Province, E of the city of AD DUJAYL vicinity (b)(2)High along MSR (b)(2)High. The unit targeted was an AEGIS convoy. No casualties or damage to equipment was reported. The convoy killed the trigger man. After a search of the body was completed, the AEGIS convoy personnel discovered det cord and command wire on the deceased AIF. He also had cotton in his ears. The AEGIS convoy detained a second individual. D/1-8 IN is taking custody of the AIF detained by AEGIS. EOD conducted post blast and reports IED was an unknown type of munition surface laid on the shoulder of the north bound lane with an unknown type of initiation system. The surviving LN says he and the other LN were traveling home when stopped by the Crescent Security Group and told to get on the ground. Once the 2xLN complied, the CSG began to fire in the direction of the LNs. The CSG engaged both LNs, hitting their motorcycle and killing one LN.





(c) Brief Description: 040900NOV06, TF 2-3 IN reported that a patrol from 549 MP conducted EOF procedures in the Ninewa Province, Mosul at (b)(2)High, IVO RTE Nissan and RTE Lexus. A moped approached the rear of the p [redacted] ate of speed and the unit initiated EOF procedures. The moped would not stop heading towards the patrol despite EOF procedures and the rear vehicle engaged the moped with SAF. This resulted in the death of the moped driver. IPs were on the scene and took the body to Al Jamouri Morgue. IPs searched the body and the bike and found nothing significant to report. There was 1xLN killed and 1x moped with damage as a result of this incident.


