

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



(c) Brief Description: TF 2 [redacted] 2/1/54 [redacted] Ps conducted an EOF in the Nine [redacted] ince, Mosul at [redacted] (b)(2)High on RTE [redacted] (b)(2)High north of the intersection of RTE [redacted] (b)(2)High. 2/1/549 MP [redacted] north on RTE [redacted] (b)(2)High when a LN vehicle appr [redacted] quickly to the rear. The trail vehicle gunner observed a vehicle with only a driver rapidly approaching at [redacted] (b)(2)High distanc [redacted] he executed hand and arm signals, but the vehicle failed to reduce speed [redacted] op. At [redacted] (b)(2)High distance, the gunner placed 10-15 rounds of 7.62mm from a M240 into the hood of [redacted] vehicle and through the windshield. The squad continued moving forward to the next available turnaround point, but the civilian vehicle stopped. The vehicle actually contained 1 x LN male, 1 x LN woman, and 1 x LN child. The female and child were located in the backseat, so were not readily visible to the gunner. The male immediately exited the vehicle, and took the child to a local hospital in another civilian vehicle that had stopped at the scene. When the MP squad arrived back on scene, only the LN female was present. They searched the vehicle with no results. The male returned to the scene 20 minutes later and reported the LN child had

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been pronounced dead at the Abu Nasir Hospital. There was 1 x LN child killed and damage to a civilian vehicle as the result of this incident.

unit initiated EOF procedures. The moped would not stop heading towards the
patrol despite EOF procedures and the rear vehicle engaged the moped with SAF. This
resulted in the death of the moped driver. IPs were on the scene and took the body to Al
Jamouri Morgue. IPs searched the body and the bike and found nothing significant to
report. There was 1xLN killed and 1x moped with damage as a result of this incident.
