(a) Date of Incident: 30 March 2006

(b) Unit: A Co., 14th EN BN

(c) Brief Description: On [redacted] ch 2006 2125, A Co., conducted an EOF on a BMW 525i, along with RTE [redacted] (b)(2) High. The vehicle was moving from north to south, and proper EOF procedure [redacted] conducted. The gunner of the lead vehicle, RG-31, shouted, flashed the spot light, shined the green beam prior to firing his weapon. The gunner fired one wa [redacted] g shot with his M16 into the shoulder of the road when the vehicle was at appx [redacted] (2) Hi meters distance and the vehicle did not show any sign of slowing down. The [redacted] nner engaged the vehicle's engine block, the vehicle seemed to slow down then suddenly sped up again turned head on towards the lead vehicle. At this point, the gunner engaged the vehicle cabin. The vehicle veered right and rolled to a stop hitting the curb. The driver was administered first aid by the platoon medic until the he was tak [redacted] here he was pronounced dead.
