The vehicle exploded when disabling rounds were fired. The driver was killed in the explosion. 709 rpts 1 LN was killed while driving a taxi in the area when the vehicle exploded. Shrapnel from the vehicle that exploded penetrated through the taxi and struck the LN in the abdomen.
