(c) Brief Description: On 3 June 2006 1026, A Co., conducted an EOF while conducting BDA on RG-31 bumper number A516, after an IED detonat N ran up to and on the Buffalo bumper number A502, SPC (b)(3), (b)(6) and SGT (b)(3), (b)(6) both issued arnings along with hand and arm signals, and then shot the LN. SGT (b)(3)(b)(6) SPC (b)(3)(b)(6) shot the LN twice. The battle space owner, 1-17 IN "Buffalo," took over the body of the LN, and A/14 EN continued mission.

(c) Brief Description: On 30 March 2006 2125, A Co., conducted an EOF on a BMW 525i, along with (b)(2)High. The vehicle was moving from north to south, and proper EOF procedures were conducted. The gunner of the lead vehicle, (b)(6) shouted, flashed the spot light, shined the green beam prior to firing his w. The gunner fired one warning shot with his M16 into the shoulder of the road when the vehicle was at appx (b)(2)High distance and the vehicle did not show any sign of slowing down. Th aged the vehicle's engine block, the vehicle seemed to slow down then suddenly sped up again turned head on towards the lead vehicle. At this point, the gunner engaged the vehicle cabin. The vehicle veered right and rolled to a stop hitting the curb. The driver was administered first aid by the platoon medic until the he was taken to the nearest hospital where he was pronounced dead.

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with the IA Seconds after the IED went off, three AIF fired AK-47s from the orchard northwest of Aski Mawsil approximately (b)(2)High m east of the IED blast. Soldiers in the first and third vehicles returned fire. At the same instant a (b)(6) ear old boy ran away from the Strykers through a wheat field towards the orchard. He was carrying a backpack. The boy was approximately (b)(2)High mm away. He was hit twice. The boy was still alive when he was transferred to the MEDEVAC bird.
