Finally, lethal shot to the driver.

- (c) Brief Description: EOF with death o VERWATCH MISSION WITH 13 SOLDIERS AT A LN'S HOUSE AT (b)(2)High THE HOUSE WAS THAT OF A DETAINED INDIVIDUAL. THE P OVERWATCHING A BLOCKING POSITION ON RIVER ROAD TO PREVENT THE MOVEMENT OF THE BARRIERS DESIGNED TO PREVENT LOCAL NATIONALS FROM BYPASSING NATIONAL POLICE

CHECKPOINTS. THE POSITION NOTICED A (b)(6) BONGO TRUCK ATTEMPTING TO BYPASS THE BARRIERS. THE BONGO TRUCK STUCK ATTEMPTING TO BYPASS. A CROWD BEGAN TO GATHER AS THERE WERE 10 VEHICLES ON THE NORTH SIDE AND 20 VEHICLES ON THE SOUTH SIDE WAITING TO BYPASS THE OBSTACLE. D/2-506 ALERTED A QRF TO MOVE TO THE INTERSECTION IN THE VICINITY OF THE BLOCKING POSITION. THE OVERWATCH POSITION THEN IDENTIFIED 2 x TRACTORS CO (b)(6) THE SITE. THE OVER WATCH POSITION SENT ONE SQUAD UNDER SSG (b)(3), b(6) CONTROL TOWARD THE BARRIERS WHILE THE REST OF THE DISMOUNT REMAINED ON THE ROOF OF THE HOUSE IN A OVERWATCH POSITION. THE 3 x VEHICLE QRF (2 x M1A2 and 14) WAS MOVING FROM WEST TO EAST DOWN SLAUGHTER ROAD AS SSG (b)(3)(b)(6) S SQUAD BEGAN ITS MOVEMENT TOWARD THE BARRIERS. WHEN THE LOCAL NATIONALS SAW THE VEHICLES APPROACHING FROM THE WEST, THEY BEGAN TO DISPERSE. IN AN ATTEMPT TO PREVENT THE LOCAL NATIONALS FROM DISPERSING, SSG (b)(3), b(6) FIRED ONE WARNING SHOT INTO THE AIR WITH HIS M4. IMMEDIATELY AFTER FIRING THIS SHOT, THE M240B ON THE ROOF FIRED ONE SHOT. THE PSG, SFC (b)(3)(b)(6), IMMEDIATELY GOT CONTROL OF THE M240B GUNNER AND PREVENTED HIM FROM FIRING ANYMORE. IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE M240B FIRED, 2 X GUNNERS (SPC (b)(3)(b)(6) AND SPC (b)(3), b(6)), WHO WERE WITH SSG (b)(3)(b)(6) FIRED, HITTING ONE VEHICLE WAITING IN THE LINE OF VEHICLES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BARRIERS. SSG (b)(3)(b)(6) IMMEDIATELY STOPPED THEM FROM CONTINUING TO FIRE. AT THIS POINT, THE LOCAL NATIONALS THAT WERE AROUND THE BARRIERS HAD DISPERSED FROM THE AREA. THE VEHICLE QRF ARRIVED AT THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE BARRIERS WHILE THE DISMOUNT ELEMENT WAS ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BARRIERS. THE BLACK VEHICLE CONTAINED ONE MALE AND ONE FEMALE. THE MALE HAD LOWER BODY GUN SHOT INJURIES AND THE FEMALE HAD A GUN SHOT WOUND TO THE CHEST. THEY WERE TREATED BY CF MEDICS AND RUSHED TO THE HOSPITAL BY THE NP. LEFT ON SCENE AFTER THE QRF ARRIVED WERE ONE TRACTOR, THE LN VEHICLE THAT WAS ENGAGED AND THREE OTHER VEHICLES. THE PATROL CONFISCATED ONE TRACTOR SO IT COULD NOT BE USED TO MOVE THE BARRIERS AGAIN. THE TRACTOR DRIVER APPROACHED THE PATROL IN AN ATTEMPT TO GET HIS TRACTOR BACK. THE PATROL DETAINED THE TRACTOR DRIVER AND TRANSPORTED HIM TO THE DHAA. ALL OTHER PERSONNEL AND VEHICLES DISPERSED AS THE QRF ARRIVED AT THE INTERSECTION. 4/4ID HAS APPOINTED A FIELD GRADE INVESTIGATING OFFICER FROM OUTSIDE THE BATTALION TO CONDUCT A 15-6 INVESTIGATION. THIS PATROL ELEMENT WILL NOT CONDUCT OPERATIONS OUTSIDE THE FOB UNTIL AAR AND APPROPRIATE RETRAINING IS CONDUCTED.

(c) Brief Description: EOF with Death of LN. 2/C CONDUCTED EOF ON A (b)(6) (b)(6) (b)(6) LICENSE PLATE (b)(6) IN THE AL FAROUK NEIGHBORHOOD (b)(2)High (b)(6) T WAS CONDUCT DISMOUNTED PATROL AT THE TIME O N THAT NEIGHBORHOOD. AT APPROXIMATELY (2)H METERS, ELEMENT TRIED YELLING AT THE LN TO GET HIM TO STOP. AT (2)HM, ELEM CONTINUED TO YELL AND USED HAND AND ARM SIGNALS TO STOP. AT (b)(2)HighM, ELEMENT FIRED SEVERAL WARNING SHOTS IN THE AIR TRYING TO GET THE VE TO STOP. AT APPROXIMATELY (2)HM, DISABLING SHOTS WERE FIRED INTO THE HOOD OF THE CAR. THE VEHICLE DID N DEVIATE FROM ITS COURSE. ELEMENT THEN SWITCHED TO LETHAL FIRES AND KILLED THE 1 X LN (b)(6) IN THE VEHICLE. OTHER CONTRIBUTING FACTORS TO THE EOF, HICLE WITH ONLY 1 X MALE LN DRESSED IN ALL WHITE. AT NO TIME DID THE VEHICLE SLOW DOWN UNTIL LETHAL FIRES WERE TAKEN. THERE WERE ALSO NO OTHER LN's IN THE VICINITY AND THE SHOPS WERE CLOSED IN THE AREA IN AN OTHERWISE FAIRLY BUSY RESIDENTIAL NEIGHBORHOOD. ELEMENT CONDUCTED SSE ON THE VEHICLE WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. X-SPRAY TESTS ON THE INDIVIDUAL AND VEHICLE WERE NEGATIVE. ELEMENT MOVED THE BODY TO THE SIDE OF THE ROAD AT (b)(2)High AND REQUESTED JCC TO RECOVER THE VEHICLE. ELEMENT MOVED BODY TO THE AL JAMOURI MORGUE AND FILED A POLICE REPORT WITH THE AL JAMOURI IP STATION. ELEMENT REQUESTED THE AL JAMOURI IP's CONTACT 1W WITH PHONE NUMBER OF FAMILY AFTER THEY SHOW UP TO CLAIM THE BODY TO FACILITATE ANY FURTHER ACTIONS.

(c) Brief Description: EOF with Death of LN. RECON/1-17 REPORTED AN EOF ON RTE BREWERS (b)(2)High 1 X LN FEM LED OUT OF A SIDE STREET IN A LIGHT BLUE CELEBRITY (LICENSE PLATE # (b)(6)). THE 1 X LN FEMALE ENTERED THE ELEMENTS PATROL BETWEEN THE 2ND A STRYKER IN OOM. RECON/1-17IN FIRED 3 X WARNING SHOTS INTO THE AIR AND VEHICLE FAILED TO COMPLY. RECON/1-17 THEN FIRED 1 X WARNING SHOT AT LN's TIRE. THE VEHICLE CONTINUED TO CLOSE ON THE STRKYERS. RECON FIRED 2 X DISABLING SHOTS AT THE SINGLE PERSON IN THE VEHICLE RESULTED IN 1 X KIA LN. RECON/1-17IN CONDUCTED SSE AND EXSPRAY OF THE VEHICLE WITH NEGATIVE RESULT. RECON/1-17 PROVIDED SECURITY FOR THE AMBULANCE.
