SUMMARY OF INCIDENT:

While on patrol of (b)(2)High from FOB Warhorse to FOB Normandy the patrol was conducting recon of a possible IED at (b)(2)High (b)(2)High a car approached the area. SGT (b)(3),(b)(6) motioned the car to stop, and when the driver refused to stop, he (b)(2)High (b)(2)High The driver again refused to stop; he then (b)(2)High (b)(2)High he car still kept approaching the area; he then fired three more rounds into the cab of the vehicle. When the vehicle stopped the patrol rendered first aid to the passengers. There were three passengers in the car, the driver was wounded in the face, the passenger in the front was killed and the passenger in the rear seat was unharmed. The patrol leader called TF 1-32 on FOB Normandy to request a MEDEVAC, it was denied due to the MEDEVAC status. The IP's got on station at 0738. They evacuated the wounded and uninjured man to the hospital. The Ambulance showed up soon after and took the dead IZ to the hospital. The patrol then continued on their way to FOB Normandy. (b)(2)High the vehicle did not stop and lethal rounds were fired into the windshield causing 1xKIA LN & 1xWIA LN, TF 1-32 is responding along with IPs to the scene and to evac the WIA. **UPDATE:** IP took the WIA and KIA to the Muqdadiah Hospital.
