(a) Date of Incident: 24 June 2006

(b) Unit: A Co., 14th EN BN

(c) Brief description: Unit conducted an EOF while executing a route clearance patrol on MSR (b)(2) High. A LN drove his vehicle at a high rate of speed towards the (b)(2) High of the patrol as they were traveling north on MSR (b)(2) High in TAI Alaska. PFC (b)(3)(b)(6) the gunner for the last vehicle in the order of (b)(2) High, used hand and arm signals in an attempt to get the driver to slow down (b)(2) High. When the driver did not respond, PFC (b)(3)(b)(6) fired a warning shot at (b)(2) High. The LN sped up at which time PFC (b)(3)(b)(6) felt that the LN showed the hostile act of using his vehicle as a platform for an SVBIED. PFC (b)(3)(b)(6) fired disabling shots at the vehicle, killing the driver at (b)(2) High.

(a) Date of Incident: 22 July 2006

(b) Unit: 2/C/1-17

(c) Brief Description of Incident: Conducted EOF on a (b)(6) Opel (b)(6). Element was conducting a dismounted patrol at the time on alley ways in the neighborhood. At approximately (b)(2) High element tried yelling at the LN to get hi op. At (b)(2) High element contin lling and used hand and arm signals. At (b)(2) High M, element fired several warning shots. At (b)(2) High, disabling shots were fired int ood of the car. The vehicle did not deviate from its course. Element then switched to lethal fires and killed 1xLN. Other contributing factors to the EOF, vehicle was a BOLO vehicle with only 1 x Male LN dressed all in white. At no time did the vehicle slow down until lethal fires were taken. There were also no other LNs in the vicinity and the shops were closed in the area in an otherwise fairly busy neighborhood.
