

TF Destroyer OPSUM 22 September 2009

At 0514Z B/3-61 CAV was engaged by three to five AAF with small arms fire at COP Keating. The Troop reported no casualties and no BDA. 1 Coy/1st ABP KDK identified four local nationals IVO CP Delta last night, one of which had suffered a gunshot wound to the leg. The ABP brought them to FOB Bostick to transfer them to ANP custody at the JCC. The wounded local national was treated by ISAF for his injuries and transferred to Bagram Air Field for further medical aid. The ANP transferred one individual back to the district center for further questioning and let the other two free on their own recognizance. Destroyer S9 made progress on the repairs of the Naray Bridge and the Samarik Bridge by paying money directly to vendors for supplies and to village elders for skilled labor. JCC Bostick conducted hourly radio checks with 2/1st ABP KDK at Barge Matal over HF radio. The ABP reported no issues today and that the local population was supporting ANSF efforts. There were no successful radio checks during the hours of 2100 to 0600 which suggests that it will be difficult to ensure that 2nd Coy monitors the radio throughout the night. TF Destroyer is currently mentoring the ABP commander to rectify this issue.

TF Destroyer OPSUM 27 September 2009

C/3-61 CAV, Hatchet/HHT/3-61 CAV, and the TF Destroyer Command Group conducted a recon of Gewi Village and identified a possible location to establish a future COP. The patrol also conducted a security meeting with the Ghazi Abad ANP and addressed a future security plan for MSR California south of Nishigam. 3/B/3-61 CAV conducted a dismounted patrol near COP Keating and was engaged by two to three AAF with ineffective small arms fire. The patrol reports the AAF fired in the air to alert other AAF in the valley. No casualties and no BDA reported. A/3-61 CAV conducted over watch ISO an ANA patrol into the valley south of COP Lowell. 2/2/984th/759th MP conducted a patrol to Naray District Center. They assessed the solar panels and the generator at the District Center. The patrol identified that a mechanic will need to be brought on the next patrol the week to repair the generator. 2 Coy/1st ABP KDK reported that at 1600L last evening one mortar round impacted IVO of Barge Matal Village and injured one local national girl. The girl received shrapnel to the head and was treated in Barge Matal with limited medical aid.
