

ASSESSMENT

Activity throughout N2KL has increased over the reporting period. The most significant events of today surround the large scale attacks targeting COP Keating and OP Fritsche. Larger scale attacks in the near term are highly probable as AAF will be emboldened by their recent successes against CF. In Nuristan, activity will remain decreased overall but attacks conducted will target CF in the Kamdesh District, likely targeting COP Lowell. Attacks and propaganda will remain increased as AAF exploit the closure of CF bases in the area. In Konar, AAF are planning for large scale attacks that are expected to take place in the near future. IDF attacks on OP Mace, FOB Bostick and Falcon Base will be seen in the coming days to fix CF in static locations. AAF will continue to focus their attacks in the Pech district. In southern Konar, attacks will be directed towards CF bases in the Sarkani and Khas Konar districts. Attacks will continue to target CF convoys traveling on MSR California and ASR San Diego. Commencement of PAKMIL OPs along the AFPAK border, and cache sites relocated from Bajaur Agency to the Dangam district, will contribute to an increase of activity as TB fighters enter the area. Increased activity, PAKMIL Ops and reporting indicate a complex attack targeting COP Monti may occur in the near term. In Laghman, AAF will continue their intimidation and targeting of ANSF to dissuade them from supporting GIROA. In Nangarhar, attacks will target LNs working for CF and GIROA. Multiple reports of leadership wanting to implement the use of suicide bombers throughout N2KL persists, but will be unlikely in many areas, as IDF and DF attacks are in AAF's favor. Attacks targeting GIROA officials and tribal leaders may increase as insurgents attempt to dissuade LNs from cooperating with GIROA and CF.

Laghman:

- AAF intend to attack the Tanga ANP Checkpoint in Qarghayee targeting CF supply convoys or jingle trucks traveling along HWY7 using RPGs and SAF, possibly in the next 24-48 hours.
- AAF will attack the Jaboom ANP Checkpoint with SAF and RPGs in the next 24-48 hours for their continued support of the GIRoA.
- Reporting indicates AAF intend to attack COP Najil with IDF, possibly in the next 24-48 hours.
- AAF are planning to attack the Dowlat Shah DC possibly in the next 24-48 hours.

Konar:

- Reporting indicates AAF plan to conduct harassment style attacks in the Korengal Valley in the next 24-48 hours. AAF are possibly in defensive postures as they believe CF will be carrying out an operation in the near term.
- Reporting indicates AAF plan to continue to conduct sporadic attacks targeting CF patrolling east of FOB Blessing along MSR Rhode Island.
- Reporting continues to indicate AAF plan to conduct attacks targeting CF convoys operating along southern MSR California in the Noor Gul District; AAF also plan to attack the Noor Gul DC in the near term.
- Multiple reports indicate AAF are planning to conduct attacks in the Dangam District IOT use the area as a staging ground for attacks on COP Monti; it is plausible that COP Monti will receive IDF in the near term.

Nangarhar:


- Three groups of AAF have massed on the mountain peaks in Pachir Wa Agam, near an UI ABP checkpoint IOT shoot down a CF helicopter of opportunity in the area.
- AAF under the JeM have recently decided to target LNs assisting GIRoA. Assassination and arrests of LNs working for the U.S. in Jalalabad, the Jalalabad PRT, or the the NDS may be targeted. This group has been known to use suicide bombers.

Nuristan:

- AAF will continue to engage CF operating in the Kamdesh District as CF EXFIL from COP Keating and OP Fritsche. **AAF will also conduct harassment attacks on COP Lowell in the next 24-72 hours** as they prepare to regroup and refit fighters for future, complex attacks.

THREAT ASSESSMENT

- AAF will continue to conduct attacks along MSR California. Attacks in the Pech and Dara Noor districts will remain. Reporting indicates attacks in the near future will be larger in scale, especially targeting FOB Blessing. Usage of suicide bombers is rumored in the Pech district. Attacks will also target CF bases in the Sarkani and Khas Konar districts.
- AAF in Nuristan will increase their attacks on CF bases in Kamdesh, using IDF as their main tactic. As the bases close, AAF will likely push down to northern Konar to conduct attacks prior to the end of the historic fighting season and the beginning of winter as travel is impeded due to snowfall in the passes.
- IED activity in southern Nangarhar will continue to screen and facilitate AAF and criminal activity in the area. Increased intimidation will also occur in these southern districts targeting both locals and ANSF to slow patrols and retain freedom of movement with GIRoA interference.





AAF Attacks Resulting in LN Causalities

NSTR

ASSESSMENT

- SIGACTs during the past week have decreased slightly in comparison to last week's trends; AAF CMDRS are also finalizing plans for large scale attacks that will be carried out in OCT and attempting to repair disagreements between various AAF groups; during the past 24 hours, attacks in northern Konar were conducted likely in an attempt to isolate CF and prevent QRF from reaching CF in the Kamdesh District
- With the downgrade of CF presence in northern Konar and in the Kamdesh District, CF can expect to see an increase of attacks targeting CF bases in northern Konar; AAF will increase IDF attacks targeting FOB Bostick and increase IDF attacks targeting Falcon Base sporadically in the near term
- It is plausible that AAF will increase OPTEMPO of attacks targeting OP Mace in an attempt to destroy the OP, AAF will likely not attempt to overrun OP Mace due to it's strategic location; AAF will begin to target OP Mace upon their regrouping/further recruitment of additional fighters, as AAF suffered significant losses on 03OCT09
- Continued attacks and reporting originating in the Noor Gul District suggests AAF are expanding their area of operations and will continue to conduct attacks in this area engaging CF convoys of opportunity in the near term



So What...

CF CAN EXPECT TO SEE HARASSING ATTACKS ON THE EXFIL OF COP KEATING AND OP FRITSCHKE IN THE NEXT 24 HOURS; AAF CDERS WILL POSSIBLY USE SUCCESS AT COP KEATING TO CONDUCT FOLLOW-ON ATTACKS TARGETING COP LOWELL IN THE NEAR TERM.

AAF Attacks Resulting in LN Casualties

NSTR

- Over the past week, kinetic activity within Nuristan has significantly decreased in comparison to prior weeks' trends; during the past 24 hours AAF conducted large, coordinated attacks targeting both COP Keating and OP Fritsche; AAF became emboldened by the withdrawal of CF in that area as a successful IO campaign IOT recruit further fighters; TB sub-commanders are likely tied to the execution of attacks that occurred during the last 24 hours while multiple other commanders participated in the coordination and conducting of the attacks
- Recent meetings held in the Kamdesh District were likely in an attempt to coordinate future attacks on CF as the 03OCT09 attack reflected a high level of coordination; despite heavy AAF casualties allegedly obtained during the attack on CF bases, AAF will use their pull among the local population and recent fighters who traveled into the eastern Nari District, Konar Province IOT maximize efforts to engage CF bases
- The 03OCT09 attack will be used by AAF as momentum to increase attacks targeting COP Lowell, then begin moving efforts south into the Konar Province; in the near term, AAF will attempt to surround COP Lowell and conduct complex attacks targeting the base; AAF's ultimate goal is to force CF out of the area; regardless of AAF's ability to overrun COP Lowell, the local populace will view CF reallocation of assets as defeat, pulling more support for insurgent efforts





DIRECT FIRE ATTACKS IN ALISHANG WILL OCCUR IN THE NEXT 24 -48 HOURS AS TALIBAN HARASS AND INTIMIDATE ANP IVO OF JABOOM; AAF LEADERS ARE POSSIBLY COORDINATING ATTACKS FOCUSING ON HWY7 CPS AND ANSF/CF LOGISTICS CONVOYS IN THE QARGHAYEE DISTRICT



ASSESSMENT

- Trends for Laghman this week indicate a continued low levels of AAF kinetic activity which is only slightly higher than 2008 activity levels; current trends will increase due to new fighters from Pakistan conducting operations in Laghman
- Recent intelligence indicated that [redacted] would b [redacted] an attack on the Tanga ANP Checkpoint on Highway1A, however previous repo [redacted] ted that [redacted] has fled to Pakistan to avoid detainment
- Taliban fighters have traveled from Tarawu in order to conduct an attack on the Jaboom ANP checkpoint using RPGs; historically, AAF have attacked the Jaboom CP in order to punish the ANP working at that CP for their support of GIROA
- Waziristan, Pakistan has facilitated the upcoming explosives attacks that are planned by providing explosives training aimed at successfully and effectively executing the attacks
- AAF leadership has distributed money from Pakistan to mid level AAF for attacks indicating an increase of attacks in central Laghman in the coming week





ASSESSMENT

- 2009 trend analysis indicates a small increase in kinetic activity that resemble 2008's level of attacks; due to a large influx of AAF from Pakistan, current trends will increase in Nangarhar as AAF conduct operations before the winter snow blocks mountain passes
- Continued GIROA/CF assistance will help enforce security and a pro-GIROA influence within the Mohmand valley, thereby suppressing overall Taliban operations in k are necessary for positive development of governance
- Gun powder smuggled from Pakistan into the Nangarhar Province has been sold to villagers linked to Taliban activities; that gun powder can be utilized in the construction of IEDs if acquired in mass quantity
- Corrupt Pakistan ISI gives the Taliban materials and logistical support aiding insurgency operations within Nangarhar; Taliban members have an established support channel through their corrupt contacts within the PAK ISID which serves to increase instability in Nangarhar



AMMONIUM NITRATE FERTILIZER BAN



Common Abbreviations:

- Ammonium Nitrate + Aluminum (ANAL)
- Ammonium Nitrate + Fuel Oil (ANFO)




Characteristics:

- Small white beads-similar to BB gun pellets
- When mixed with diesel fuel, there may be evidence of oily residue and strong Ammonia odor
- Milky when mixed with water



How to Identify AN



On 23 September 2009, the Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigations and Livestock (MAIL) sent a letter to HQ ISAF, NDS and the MOI endorsing a ban on Ammonium Nitrate (AN) fertilizers which is already illegal, and permitting ANSF/CF personnel to confiscate if found.

IED analysts have assessed that 85% of HME IEDs in Afghanistan consist of AN as a main charge. With the ban and subsequent legal permission given to NASF/CF to confiscate AN, it is assessed AAFs ability to emplace large numbers of HME IEDs and large main charges will severely diminish once stockpiles are used. As a result it is possible that IED activity will drop until AAF can find alternatives to AN. An issue that may arise as a result is ANSF/CF personnel enforcing the ban and coming into conflict with legitimate users of AN fertilizers.

Ammonium Nitrate is the most common HME precursor, yet its legitimate demand in Afghanistan is minimal as it is not as suitable an agricultural fertilizer as urea. Its complete elimination from introduction into Afghanistan would not create a significant agricultural burden. Illegalization and elimination of AN as a precursor would likely increase the use of Potassium Chlorate-based explosives and while this precursor material is readily available in common Afghanistan household products, it is not a necessity and its access could be restricted. AAF will continue to utilize and identify precursor chemicals to use in the production of HME. The elimination of AN will not have an impact immediately, however once stockpiles are depleted operations could be effected.
