



ASSESSMENT

Activity in N2KL has slightly decreased over the past 24 hours. In Nuristan, AAF will increase attacks IVO of COP Keating and Lowell in the near term. Attacks will remain disruptive in nature to screen to movement of MWE. In Konar, AAF continue to target CF in the Pech district, centering their attacks on fixed locations. AAF leadership continues to be active in the Konar province, especially in the Pech and Dara Noor districts. This increased activity of senior leadership could indicate planning for future attacks or operations for later in the season when leadership often leaves the area. AAF are likely celebrating Eid while simultaneously awaiting funding and ammunition for future attacks. Stand-off style attacks will be prevalent in the near term as insurgents move MWE into the area. In Laghman, activity remains low. AAF will continue to emplace IEDs along MSRs in the near term. An emerging TTP as of late has been emplacing IEDs the night prior to an attack is scheduled to take place. These IEDs will be used to restrict movement and slow patrols traversing the area. In Nangarhar, activity remains decreased. AAF will emplace IEDs and conduct small arms fire attacks against ANSF/CF in southeastern provinces. These attacks will be used to slow CF patrols, facilitate illicit activity and protect freedom of movement. Attacks in the near future will potentially be directed at ANSF/CF facilities or GIROA officials, as AAF have reportedly begun an assassination campaign directed at Pro-GIRoA members.

Laghman:

- Reporting indicated COP Najil and the Dowlat Shah District Center would be attacked after Ramadan. Attacks conducted will potentially be seen at the end of Eid, which may occur as soon as the next 24-48 hours.

Konar:

- Reporting indicates AAF have planned for an unspecified attack on 22SEP09, it is plausible that **AAF will carry out an IDF attack targeting COP HONAKER MIRACLE in the next 24-48 hours.**

- Reporting indicates **AAF plan to attack COP Badel on 22SEP09.**
- AAF will likely continue to conduct attacks targeting CF patrolling elements operating in eastern Pech and western Dara Noor.

Nangarhar:


- Earlier reporting suggested AAF planned to attack the Pachir Wa Agam District center on 19 or 20 SEP 09. This attack has yet to occur; it is possible this will occur following Eid, which could be as soon as the next 24-48 hours.

Nuristan:

- AAF will continue to conduct attacks targeting COP Lowell and COP Keating in the near term.**

THREAT ASSESSMENT

- AAF will increase harassing direct and IED initiated attacks throughout Konar province to slow CF targeting and patrols in the area. Attacks will target CF bases throughout Pech and Dara Noor districts with IDF and SAF from stand-off distances. IED and ambushes along MSR Rhode Island will be emplaced to interfere with CF/ANSF operations in the area. Attacks will be most prevalent along western portions of Rhode Island due to AAFs freedom of movement and unpaired surfaces.
- The presence of multiple AAF leadership in Konar for a sustained period possibly indicates planning and staging for future attacks. AAF are possibly awaiting funding and supplies before being able to carry out multiple large-scale attacks which will potentially surround the conclusion of Eid. Attacks until then will primarily consist of IDF and other harassment style engagements as their main tactics.
- IED activity in southern Nangarhar will continue to screen and facilitate AAF and criminal activity in the area. Increased intimidation will also occur in these southern districts targeting both locals and ANSF to slow patrols and retain freedom of movement with GIROA interference.





AAF Attacks Resulting in LN Casualties

NSTR

- SIGACTS during the past week have decreased in comparison to both previous weeks and 2008 trends; this decrease in activity can be partially attributed to AAF's continued attempts to stockpile weapons with winter approaching, infighting between AAF groups, and an emphasis on meetings to plan for the winter.
- AAF operating in central Konar have recently experienced a shortage in finances, which is a contributing factor to the lull in activity in this area; currently obtaining funding via his contacts in PAK, AAF are awaiting the arrival of these funds IOT acquire further weapons and munitions and conduct further attacks targeting CF bases and patrolling elements in central Konar; AAF operating under CMDR Toralay are awaiting a donation of weapons and munitions in the Ganjal Valley upon acquiring the weapons and funding in exchange for AAF not to attack a local reconstruction effort, AAF will possibly increase attack activity in the Ganjal Valley upon acquiring the weapons and funding.
- For the near term, CF can expect to see continued stand-off style attacks targeting CF bases and patrolling elements; AAF will likely continue to attack CF static locations that are located along key AAF facilitation routes in an attempt to divert CF attention from AAF movement of MWE into the Konar Province; AAF continue to plan for attacks that will be conducted in the next few weeks prior to the onset of winter months.
- AAF are possibly preparing to emplace IEDs along RTE Beaverton at the mouth of the Ganjal Valley; although IEDs are not historically seen in the area, recent indications suggest that TB CMDR Toralay was attempting to construct an IED in the Ganjal Valley but the IED prematurely detonated, which also suggests that IEDs will be ineffective until AAF bring IED experts into the area; AAF in the Ganjal area will likely initiate ambushes with an IED followed by SAF/RPG IVO Sarkani Village where AAF have established some level of LN support.





ASSESSMENT

- Over the past week, AAF within Nuristan have slightly decreased attack levels in comparison to prior weeks' trends; expect to see a continued decrease in kinetic activity during the near term as the majority of prior attacks were focused on Barge Matal Village prior to CF withdrawing forces from the area; activity in western Nuristan will continue to remain minimal in the upcoming weeks, attacks in this area historically
- CF can expect to see sporadic attacks targeting COP Lowell, COP Keating and OP Fritsche in the near term, as AAF are assessed to be in the middle of their attack cycle; AAF have historically conducted attacks in this area periodically over a course of 3-4 days, which is then followed by a rest/refit period lasting for a short period of time; attacks targeting the CF bases in the area will consist primarily of DF attacks (SAF/RPGs)
- Attacks targeting CF in the Kamdesh District, namely COP Keating, had previously consisted of B-10 recoilless rifle; however, no attacks using B-10 fire have occurred since the 29AUG09 possibly due to the CF bomb drop on the area, indicating CF have either destroyed the weapon's system or ironically AAF have not been able to acquire B-10 ammunition since 29AUG09





AAF WILL TARGET COP NAJIL AND THE DOWLAT SHAH DISTRICT CENTER WITH IDF IN THE NEAR TERM. CWIEDS IN ALISHANG WILL CONTINUE TARGETING ANSF/CF VEHICLES TRAVELING ALONG THE NORTH PORTION OF MSR NEBRASKA.



ASSESSMENT

- Trends for Laghman this week indicate a decrease from last week; we can expect to see activity for this week to closely follow Laghman's 2008 trends
- AAF in the vicinity of Qala Najil are focusing on stand-off attacks; AAF are emplacing IEDs by burying them the night before an attack is scheduled to be executed in order to minimize the potential of being detained by ANSF/CF; expect to see continued use of CWIEDs in the Alishang District
- AAF are preparing for a large scale post-Ramadan attack targeting the Dowlat Shah District Center and Combat Outpost Najil
- AAF are removing the command wire from landmines after emplacing them in order to use the IED later; this TTP may explain the incomplete IEDs found in the NKL area



So What...

ON 20SEP09, AAF WERE REPORTED TO BE PLANNING A COMPLEX ATTACK ON THE PACHIR WA AGAM DISTRICT CENTER WHICH WAS NOT OCCURRED TO DATE, AAF WILL CONDUCT ATTACK AT CONCLUSION OF EID; AAF WILL TARGET [REDACTED] AND HIS SUPPORTS IN ACHIN IN THE NEAR FUTURE IOT RETAIN CONTROL AND REMOVE GIROA SUPPORTERS

ASSESSMENT

- For the second consecutive week trend analysis indicates a continued decrease in kinetic activity; this year's level of attacks remains below the 2008 historical trends which may indicate disruption caused by CF/ANSF operations; expect an increase in attacks after the Eid Al-Fitr holiday has passed and AAF attempt to expend munitions prior to the winter months
- Hezb-e Islami/Gulbuddin members are conducting intimidation on ANA soldiers in Surkh Rod; HiG members go to the villages in order to intimidate the supporters of GIROA; HIG members are not supportive of the government of Afghanistan unless their goals are similar to the goals of Hezb-e Islami/Gulbuddin
- CF detained AAF who were possibly affiliated with an AAF IED cell operating in Khogyani; the detainees claimed that IED construction materials were for making repairs although wire cutters are rarely used to repair vehicles



Justification for Imagery: TF Gryphon requests FMV/EO/IR IOT assess flood damage to HWY1A and assist in mission planning for alternate routes along the route. CF, ICW ANSF, prepare to coordinate reconstruction efforts, traffic control measures, and possible vehicle staging areas along the route as logistical moves are halted due to limited traffic ability. Failure to launch FMV will force CF and ANSF to coordinate without proper SA of the extent of the damage along the route.

Reporting prior to the elections indicated an increase in AAF threat along southern Konar targeting CF and election supporters. Several hotspots exist along MSR California where previously convoys have received IED, RPG, and SAF attacks during logistical moves. Failure to recon and overwatch the MSR with FMV will further decrease SA for CF while conducting its mission.


Significant Date Threats and Assessments

Ramadan

- During this period, there has been no decrease in activity that has been attributable to Ramadan. The increase observed during the latter part of the Pre-Ramadan period is a direct result of election related attacks. Supply issues will be the biggest factor contributing to the decrease observed during this Ramadan period. Reporting continues to indicate attacks will commence once supply levels return to acceptable amounts.
- The timing of Ramadan this year will likely see insurgent and criminal activity remain increased across N2KL due to favorable weather conditions, the peak of the fighting season, as well as election related events and a possible election run-off.
- Attacks will likely recommence once supplies return to an acceptable level. These attacks will focus on CF bases to avoid local casualties. Election results being released just after the Laiatul-Qadr (Night of Power) observance could provoke demonstrations and increased propaganda. Large crowds will present viable targets for possible suicide bombs however to avoid negative IO, AAF will refrain from such attacks instead targeting ANSF, CF and GIROA facilities.
