Report Log of Complex Attack on COP Keating/OP Fritsche

03 October 2009

ALL TIMES IN ZULU

1. 0130: SALTUR received from B/3-61 TOC stating COP Keating (b)(2)High is receiving SAF and B-10 fire from the east. Unit responded with SAF and 120mm m
2. 0132: Keating CP reports "We need it [known that] we have mortars pinned down and fire coming [from] everywhere."
3. 0133: Black Knight TOC (B/3-61) reports "Fritsche and Keating [are] in heavy contact. Requesting Air TIC be opened. We need something."
4. 0133: Keating CP reports "Fritsche is taking heavy machine gun fire as well."
5. 0135: Black Knight TOC reports "Still taking IDF. [We] need something [as] our mortars can't get up. We are taking [casualties]. Get something up."
6. 0137: TF Destroyer Battle Captain relays from B/3-61 "Fritsche and Keating still taking heavy contact."
7. 0140: Keating CP reports "We are taking contact from diving board, switchbacks, putting green and B-10 position. We are taking heavy SAF and RPGs. RPGs [are] from the north face."
8. 0142: TF Palehorse Battle Captain, in response to question from Keating, replies "Negative. AH (AWT) are being alerted time now. It's a 40 minute flight."
9. 0142: TF Destroyer tells Keating "[Black Knight,] (b)(2)High en route. No ETA yet."
10. 0143: Keating CP asks "What's the status of air?"
11. 0144: TF Destroyer responds "CAS 5 minutes."
12. 0144: Keating CP states "We are taking fire from inside Urmul Village."
13. 0148: Keating CP states "Our mortars are still pinned down [and] unable to fire."
14. 0150: Keating CP states "We need CAS. [We] are still taking heavy RPG and machine gun fire at both locations. Fritsche and Keating [still] taking heavy contact [from] the switchbacks from Urmul [and] the diving board and north face at Keating. Fritsche is surrounded as well"
15. 0153: Keating CP reports "Multiple enemies [are] running through the ANP station and fire [is] coming from the mosque in Urmul. [The] priority is switchback and putting green."
16. 0154: Keating CP reports "ASG [are] attacking OP Fritsche at this time."
17. 0158: Keating CP reports "We are still taking effective RPG [fire] at Keating from the ANP station. Everyone at the police station is shooting at us. ASG [have] given up their OP at Fritsche. Enemy is 50 meters from the wire on the high ground."
18. 0202: TACP reports (b)(2)High JTAC) sending 9-line for bomb drop."
19. 0202: Keating CP reports "[We] just took another casualty."
20. 0202: TF Destroyer asks "What type of injury?"
21. 0203: Keating CP responds "They are taking them to the aid station and we will get the updates."
22. 0203: Black Knight TOC reports "We just lost [our] SATCOM. [If] we lose MIRC, we are blacked out."

23. 0207: TF Palehorse reports "Kamdesh TIC response: (b)(2)High wheels up JAF at 0205."
24. 0208: TF Destroyer S2 reports "Be advised that Keating and Fritsche are in heavy contact ATT, previous reporting stated that AAF were planning major coordinated attacks against Keating, Lowell, and possibly Mace IOT allow FOM of fighters moving on Barge Matal.":
25. 0209: TF Palehorse reports "MEDEVAC (b)(2)High wheels up JAF at 0208."
26. 0211: Keating CP reports "[The ANP station is] the biggest spot right now. They are locked onto the trucks with RPGs. OP Fritsche is about to pop claymores. They are that close to the wire.
27. 0212: Keating CP reports "We still can't get CAS up on the CAG net."
28. 0214: Keating CP, in response to an unknown question, responds "That's up at Fritsche and they are almost in the wire there. I don't think they are monitoring that but (b)(2)High (b)(2)High
29. 0215: Keating CP reports "Our mortars are still pinned down."
30. 0216: OP Mace reports "[The] AAF are actively talking about breaching the wire. Frequencies (b)(2)High
31. 0218: Keating CP reports "[The] AAF are attempting to breach [the] ANA side of COP Keating. [The] AAF took one of the ANA according to the ANA commander."
32. 0128: Keating CP reports "Fritsche is 100% on equipment and personnel."
33. 0219: Keating CP reports "Enemy in the wire at Keating."
34. 0220: Black Knight TOC reports "Enemy in the wire! Enemy in the wire!"
35. 0221: Keating CP asks "How long until CCA [is on station]? We need support. We have enemy on the COP."
36. 0223: TF Destroyer reports "Enemy in the wire at COP Keating. They breached from the ANA side of the COP to the west."
37. 0226: TACP reports (b)(2)High dropping 2x GBU-38."
38. 0225: Black Knight TOC lost MIRC capability.
39. 0232: TF Destroyer reports "COP Keating is at their last fighting position. They are getting overrun and need CAS. As much as possible."
40. 0237: TF Destroyer reports "OP Fritsche reports they are shooting 120mm mortars at COP Keating. They (Fritsche) are no longer taking contact from the south. They are supporting Keating's last battle position."
41. 0240: OP Mace (b)(2)High reports "Gist: keep in contact with your guys up there. I can't reach them from down here. There are 3x WIA and 1x KIA."
42. 0244: TF Destroyer puts all combat outposts and FOB Bostick at 1005 force protection in defensive positions.
43. 0246: TF Destroyer reports "Black Knight wants to engage everything from the western ECP to their TOC. Anything outside the wire is hostile and needs to be engaged."
44. 0249: TF Destroyer reports "There is another AWT and MEDEVAC bird en route from BAF. [They will be waiting on Bostick] when [the] birds go to FARP they [AWT] will take off to provide overwatch."
45. 0249: TF Destroyer reports "SITREP from (b)(2)High 2x US KIA, 1x US WIA (Urgent), 6x ANA WIA at COP KEATING."

46. 0250: TF Palehorse reports "Kamdesh TIC response station at Keating and Fritsche at 0246." (b)(2)High on
47. 0251: TF Destroyer reports "OP Fritsche is no longer taking contact from the south. They are monitoring the south and getting Javelins out."
48. 0254: TF Destroyer EWO reports "EW on station (b)(2)High in the vicinity of Keating on (b)(2)High
49. to get to the mortar pit to get their guns operations."
50. 0258: TF Destroyer relays report from OP Fritsche stating that "They have an RPG stuck in a HESCO barrier that didn't explode. Request that EOD is informed for when they do the retrograde."
51. 0301: TF Destroyer relays report from Keating "SITREP: 2x US KIA, 3x US WIA, 6x ANA WIA at COP Keating. 4x US WIA at OP Fritsche."
52. 0323: TF Destroyer reports "COP Keating receiving SAF, RPG, and HAF from mosque at (b)(2)High 2248."
53. 0327: TACP reports (b)(2)High drops 2x GBU-38 on (b)(2)High
54. 0332: TF Destroyer relays "OP Fritsche reports negative contact. [They are] supporting Keating with mortars."
55. 0336: TF Destroyer relays "OMLT and ANA are working to clear ANA compound. They are working on taking the maintenance building as they believe that is last [element] of AAF on Keating."
56. 0342: TF Destroyer reports "AWT is wheels down at Bostick for FARP."
57. 0349: OP Fritsche reports receiving sporadic fire. They are returning with SAF and still supporting Keating with 120mm."
58. 0342: TF Destroyer reports "AWT FARP complete. Wheels up at Bostick and en route to Keating."
59. 0358: OP Fritsche reports "Negative contact at this time. [We are] still supporting Keating with 120mm."

66. 0520: COP Keating reports that they have retaken another building but cannot push any farther due to a lack of manpower."
67. 0529: COP Fritsche reports "Black on 7.62mm linked ammunition."
68. 0536: (b)(2)High (AWT) returning to Bostick.
69. 0539: g clears any ordnance drop within 200m of the COP.

92. 0639: TF Destroyer informs COP Keating that element walking in will have a resupply of 7.62mm linked ammunition.
93. 0639: COP Keating reports they are also black on .50 caliber linked ammunition.
94. 0643: COP Keating reports a break in the action. Are taking accountability of men, weapons and equipment. Also report 1x WIA (critical requires MEDEVAC within 3-5 hours. Vitals 120/60 and 118."
