1. (q) What is the nature and extent of loss of military equipment?

I received my information from B/3-61 Inventory documents, initiated 48 hours after they were pulled out of Keating. The first day was a "down" day, for seclusion and rest. I have enclosures of what I received as far as losses. It was not easy to differentiate at that time what was pulled out damaged, or what was just not there. General comments thru BN S4 channels was that very little that was damaged was pulled out as they knew it would be bombed and it was just sifting thru burned out buildings. (2 enclosures, one for lost ORG, one for lost TPE. Enclosures were expected to have only small changes once final FLIPL was established about a week later). Answer concludes.

2. What, if any, recurring problems or challenges were there in equipment and/or supplies to COP Keating? Was there any force protection or other supplies that were necessary but never available to COP Keating?

No known recurring problems. We would have a hard time getting them over 20 days of supply for fuel and ammo resupply was frequent, due to it being air-only and Barge Matal had a lot of air asset investment. They had all the surveillance and detection equipment that any other locations had, and all the COPs in 3-61CAV and 2-12 IN had the best gear as they were the Cdr's Priority for the region. No known open requests for force protection supplies or any special equipment. I believe after RIP in June all those COPs did some upgrading of force prot measures utilizing barrier supplies, but it was mostly small scale improvements not any large projects. Answer concludes.
