9. I, (b)(3), (b)(6), WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On the 3rd of Oct COP Keating was taking contact and requested air support. I posted a TIC banner at 0133z providing where the contact was coming from and what frequency the aircraft would be able to communicate to the JTAC (myself). While the process was underway, I asked (b)(2)High (L(b)(3), (b)(6) through mirc to describe what was going on. This information would be used in a 9-line that is required to pass for an aircraft to release ordinance. While we were waiting for (b)(2)High to check in, I kept getting updates from the Destroyer TOC staff and (b)(2)High checked 0154z around 20 minutes later and provided a fighter to FAC brief. The fighter to FAC brief is a run down of the fighters capabilities, then an AO update. An AO update allows the JTAC to provide the aircraft a quick picture of what is going on and what is the ground commanders intent. When (b)(2)High checked on he was still a few miles away (minutes away in reference to time) from FOB Bostick enroute to COP Keating. We passed the fighter to FAC brief, AO update and coordinated where to set their aircraft so we can continue with good line of sight communications. We then provided him with a 9-line to employ on enemy personnel engaging on the COP. After a few mintues we had (b)(2)High employ a GBU 31 (2,000lb bomb) at 0216z on (b)(2)High, which subsided some fire. After the initial release (b)(2)High informed me that there were good effects and passed more targets around COP Keating. We had (b)(2)High release (b)(2)High x GBU 38's (2 x 500lb bombs) with 20 meter seperation on (b)(2)High. Then continued with 2 x 20mm gun runs on (b)(2)High (b)(2)High. The gun runs where requested to supress the enemy that was in close proximity to COP Keating. With out a JTAC on the ground at COP Keating, we had to enforce the risk estimate distance from friendly forces and hopefully provide effective gun passes to support the ground units. Then (b)(2)High checked on station right after (b)(2)High at 0305z. He stayed on station the most time out of all aircraft, his playtime on station was close to 7-8 hours assisting me in providing AO update and altitude block deconfliction, conducting as a FAC-A. (b)(2)High employed 2 x GBU 38's (2 x 500lb bombs) on (b)(2)High at 0340z. and also did a 20mm gun run on (b)(2)High at 0402z. (b)(2)High arrived on station at 0426z, while (b)(2)High employed 1 x GBU 31 (1 x 2,000lb bomb) on (b)(2)High at 0521z. Afterward (b)(2)High and had his wingman engage with 1 x GBU31 (1 x 2,000lb bomb) on (b)(2)High at 0611z. The time that elapsed in between drops, I was getting targeting data from (b)(2)High from the TACSAT. (b)(2)High arrived on station at 0548z, that is when I recieved intel report from (b)(2)High Brigade JTAC) that there was a report of a DSHKA position on the high ground to the west of Keating. I quickly passed to (b)(2)High this location and requested a patern of a circle around the grid provided from brigade. (b)(2)High released 6 x GBU 38's at 0627z to supress that target and ensured that the helicopters would not need to be threatend by the DSHKA. (b)(2)High also employed 2 x squares of 4 GBU 31's on (b)(2)High and (b)(2)High at 0909z and at 0916z. These where locations in between COP Keating and OP Fritsche that the enemy embedded themselves as an overwatch position and was shooting down on COP Keating. (b)(2)High (SSg (b)(3), (b)(6) told me that he was on his way out with the QRF and he needed information on what is going on. Could not pass that information to him, cause he was told that the QRF was ready to fly out on a helicopter in a few min. I continued to control multiple assets from (b)(2)High to (b)(2)High over Keating, supressing enemy DSHKA locations and small arms/RPG teams. (b)(2)High employed 1 x 114 hellfire at YE 11547 22572 at 1104z on 4 enemy personnel on the outside of COP Keating, shooting towards the COP. Once the contact subsided and the QRF team was enplace moving from OP Fritsche to COP Keating I released control to (b)(2)High
