MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: (U) AR 15-6 Interview with General (Gen) Joseph F. Dunford, Jr., Commander, International Security Assistance Force (ISAF) and US Forces – Afghanistan (USFOR-A)

1. (U) The investigation team conducted an office call with Gen Joseph F. Dunford, Jr., Commander, ISAF and USFOR-A at his headquarters in Kabul, Afghanistan on 24 June 2013 as part of the AR 15-6 Investigation into the attack on the Camps Bastion-Leatherneck-Shorabak (BLS) Complex on 14-15 September 2012 in Helmand Province, Afghanistan. The following is a summary of the main points from the office call.

a. (U//~~FOUO~~) The investigation team provided Gen Dunford an update on the progress of the investigation, and preliminary items that he may be interested in as the Commander of ISAF and USFOR-A. These items included the importance of unity of command for the protection of coalition bases, the vulnerabilities that may be created during a drawdown of forces, the importance of providing oversight and corrective actions for vulnerabilities identified in Joint Staff Integrated Vulnerability Assessments (JSIVA), and the recommendation to conduct a JSIVA or US Central Command Vulnerability Assessment on all post-2014 bases in Afghanistan.

b. (U//~~FOUO~~) Gen Dunford acknowledged the progress of the investigation and the preliminary items of interest. He then discussed the current enemy and friendly situations in Afghanistan.
