



TOTAL INSPECTION RATES







TF-SAFE Fire Prevention Program

- Regional Fire Protection Specialists (FPS's)
 - ✓ Move to a different Bases in their Region.
 - ✓ Evaluate fire prevention inspection program of every fire department.
 - Work with O&M provider and Mayor cell to assure all fire deficiencies identified are corrected in a timely manner.
 - ✓ Evaluate Fire Warden training and program.
 - Provide Fire Warden training to sites with no fire department.
 - ✓ Conduct High risk facility inspections (DFAC, MWR, Shops, etc...)
 - ✓ Conduct inspections on all facilities on over 52 bases with no fire department.
