(BC0003) Airport Police Local Police Station: The Team held another basic Glock and range safety course, with eight IPs trained. 39 have completed this course in the last five days.

(BC0041) Al Mesbah Local Police Station: PTT mentored the IP assigned to the detention facility, reminding him that all detainees were to be fed everyday, provided with water, and allowed to see family members on visitation day. The same IP was mentored on creating and maintaining a log book with which to track visitors.

(BC0051) Al Rasheed Local Police Station: PTT team picked up station equipment which included 107 Glockes, 36 portable radios, and nine vehicle radios. The Glockes will not be issued to IPs until appropriate training is completed. All IPs receiving a Glock must have a badge issued by MOI.

(BC0067) Al Tarmiya Local Police Station: The PTT team was told some of the station's IPs are suspected of harassing and physically abusing construction workers at the new station. One IP had already been arrested and another summoned from the new station and taken into custody. More IPs are believed to be involved the Team photographed all of the on-duty IPs and did a photo line-up with the workers. Two workers picked out eight IPs they said were responsible, with six out of the eight being arrested while in formation. The other two were at home. There were tense moments when this was done as several IPs threatened to quit

A joint patrol was mounted to recover reported bodies, but turned back due to unexploded bombs in the area of the reported bodies.

A neighboring stations IPs arrived with three bodies and wanted help in getting them to the morgue. The team did an escort as far as Camp Taji, then returning to the station.

At 0145 hrs the JCC received a radio call from the north TCP that they were surrounded and under SAF. A joint patrol was mounted. At the TCP the only individuals observed shooting were IPs. No other firing was heard and nobody else was seen in the area.

An Najaf

All missions to the Najaf Province were cancelled due to the suicide bombing at the Iman Ali Mosque in Najaf.

(No FFID # assigned) Crucible Training Academy: A graduation ceremony for 112 IPs and border patrol police officers was held. This was the culmination of a two week training program held at Camp Duke. The IPs included 43 from Najaf, 45 from Karbala and 24 from the border patrol.

(MN0022) Al Rabaein DHQ: PTT arrived at the Al Rabaein police station and met the station's commander. He advised one of the station's IPs was killed in a drive by shooting this morning while he was on vacation in the Yarmook district. No further information was available.

The station commander also said eight mortars were found by IP's in a Yarmook sheep market. All of the mortars were transported to Provincial HQ.

(MN0928) Abi Tamaami DHQ: PTT traveled to the above location to conduct an inspection and a class on vehicle searches. During the training there was an attack on IP from the Al Zuhor station who were conducting a patrol in the Al Sukar area. The patrol received small arms fire after an IED was detonated. Two IP were injured and transported to Al Jamour hospital. One vehicle was damaged during the attack. The two IP received injuries to the head and their condition is unknown.

Three IP were injured when an IED detonated near the Suhadeen Bridge. The detonation impacted the driver's side of the 2007 Chevrolet crew cab truck. The impact injured the IP, who was seated on driver's side rear seat passenger, causing lacerations to his head and face. A check of the IP at the emergency room revealed his injuries were not life threatening.

(RA0013) Fallujah District Police HQ: The Major Crimes Unit has not completed the move to the old District Headquarters Building. The building is now connected to city power. Repairs are being completed on air conditioning units in the building.

No training classes have been conducted this week due to IPs being absent from work. IP Training Staff plans to resume classes when the IP absence issue is resolved.

The station has 933 IPs and is rated for 1000 IPs. The QRF Unit has been moved from the Major Crimes Section to the Patrol Section. This changes the number in the patrol section from 397 IPs to 469 IPs.

On 08 Aug 06, IP Lt. [redacted] was shot and killed near his home while off duty.

On 9 Aug 06, IP [redacted] was shot and killed near Abdul Aziz Mosque. IP Faras [redacted] was shot and killed in Jolan Park. Both IPs were off duty. There are no known suspects in either case.

The PTT team met with SSR Major (b)(7)(c). We discussed the needs of the stations that are under consideration for QRF funding. Most of the site security issues have been addressed and taken care of by SSR, but some stations are still lacking in this area. The infrastructure issues of these stations were also discussed. The paper work is now being sent through the Italian chain of command for the proper approval.

A date has been set in the near future to meet with the Chief of Police, District and Station commanders. Due to security reasons the date and time is not being posted in this brief. The agenda for this meeting will outline the QRF funding and obtain the authorization from the IP commanders to begin the QRF process for each station. We will ask for any specific issues that the commanders feel should be addressed with each station as well, if not already on the project list. Once the IP commanders sign off on the project, it will be sent through the CPATT chain of command. This project seems to be a priority for SSR.

As a result of the Iraqi's refusal to allow MNF and PTT team access into the PJOC on 08/09/06, phone calls were made by the Australians to the Governor's Office. Initially, Iraqi officials claimed that MNF had not properly sought permission in advance prior to responding to the City of Al Samawah. Suffice it to say both sides conceded that there had been a misunderstanding concerning the lines of communication.

The immediate goal, for the Over Watch Program, will be to return to the City of Al Samawah and complete the previously stated mission. The tasking of this mission will be deliberate and the schedule has already been tentatively set.
