**(TD0020) Buhriz Local Police Station:** (TRA Level 3) PTT-D conducted a night mission to Buhriz LPS. The Team spoke with COL [redacted] who he advised there are 207 IP assigned to the station and that 11 check points are manned. He further advised his IP conduct 6 patrols per day. COL [redacted] says that AIF forces have been threatening to kill the IP from the station and attack the station. The COL advised his request for ammunition and fuel are going unanswered. He was able to show PPT-D 9 copies of requests with the latest request being on 13 August 2007.

**(TD0024) Diyala Provincial Police HQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT-P met with CPT [redacted] of the Major Crimes Unit, Provincial Headquarters. CPT [redacted] advised that there were 17 detainees in the MCU holding area. PTT-P requested CPT [redacted] review the circumstances for the arrest of 3 individuals that had been in custody and released from the Baqubah DHQ September 12, 2007. The CPT provided the requested information.

**(TD0111) Tahrir Local Police Station:** (TRA Non Active Station) PTT-D conducted a night mission to Tahrir LPS and spoke with CPT [redacted]. PTT-D completed an initial assessment of the station as this is a new station for the team. An inventory of the arms room was completed and a copy was given to CPT [redacted]. CPT [redacted] advised that there are 131 IP assigned to the station and 65 working on this date's shift.

**(TD0109) Al Hawaidir Local Police Station:** (TRA Level 2) PTT-D conducted a night mission at the station and spoke with LT [redacted]. PTT-D was advised of several problems dealing with the Baqubah Guardians. According to the IP at the station, they continue to be threatened by the group. PTT-D gave several suggestions concerning this and to keep investigating and to arrest and report those in the group who are breaking the law.

**(TD0604) Baqubah District HQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT-D responded to Baqubah DHQ in response to a reported protest by the Baqubah Guardians. PTT-D met with COL [redacted] and informed him of the possible protest. The Team further advised him on what preventative action could be taken so that the station would be best prepared for any incidents. PTT-D remained at the station for the entire day as a QRF for additional PTT-D teams in the area.

**(TD0607) New Baqubah Local Police Station:** (TRA Level 4) PTT-D conducted a night time mission at New Baqubah station. PTT-D spoke with CPT [redacted] who advised that 3 IP were kidnapped by the Baqubah Guardians, and released later the same day. [redacted] told PTT-D that they are trying to have good relations with the Guardians, but it is very difficult. PTT-D advised [redacted] that they will investigate the situation. CPT [redacted] told PTT-D that construction of the station is going well and will be finished soon. PTT-D inspected the arms room and everything was in order.

**Baqubah Training Academy FOB Gabe:** Practical excises were conducted on all subject matters with 31 IP in attendance and all graduating. All IP in attendance graduated the course. Graduation was attended by GEN [redacted] and various Local Police Chiefs from the surrounding area.

**(TD0006) Muqdadia District Police HQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT-D performed an assessment of the Force Protection. No additional training was conducted on this date. PTT-D also visited the Muqadiyah DHQ. PTT-D then set up a LZ at check point # 332 and waited for the arrival of VIP's which were scheduled to have a meeting at the Muqadiyah JCC. IP were mentored and advised on security measures and protection of the VIP's.

**(TA0005) Ad Dwar DHQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT and CF conducted a meeting with the Ad Dwar District HQ Command Staff. During this meeting several items were addressed. The top priority was still logistics with Provincial HQ. Not only was the DHQ Command Staff present, but most of the local station Commanders were present. The District has a solid Command staff in place, but is in need of regular IP to lead. LTC [redacted] stated he did receive the ammunition that Provincial HQ gave them, but the numbers PTT received from him were different that was written down by the Provincial Team. LTC [redacted] the District TO, stated that his IP are in need of advanced classes from the Academy in the areas of crime scene investigation, patrol tactics and written reports. PTT informed him that these classes can be taught by PTT and that PTT has the entire curriculum needed for these classes. These classes will be held in the near future.

**(TA none) Mujamma LPS:** (TRA Level 4) PTT performed an inspection of the station and noted a serious need for force protection items for this station. The greatest need is C-Wire and HESCO barriers. The station is located close to the market area and local apartment buildings, that have line of sight with most of the station grounds. There is one fighting position on the second floor which is in need of sandbags to secure it better from local line of sight. These issues will be addressed when the PTT meets with the Commander of the station. The station is not on the local power grid and does not have electricity 24/7. PTT did not see a generator that is capable of operating the essential needs for this station. This results in the Detention Facility not being fully operational.

**(TA0084) Samarra District HQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT delivered a computer that the PTT had repaired. LT [redacted] stated he purchased 6 fuel pumps for the vehicles, which should be installed this week. This would ensure 6 more working vehicles. PTT also visited the courthouse and observed the contractor working on the building. The contractors have stripped the walls and started to re-plaster them. They stated they will start painting at the end of this week or beginning of next week.

**(TA0048) Amerili DPS:** (TRA Level 4) PTT met with MAJ [redacted] to discuss station operations and any issues he may have. PTT learned that MAJ [redacted] has not done anything with the 100 AK-47's he received from CF. The MAJ advised the weapons are dirty and rusty and he refused to try and clean them up to make them usable. He was told he needed to make the effort to repair the weapons.

**(NO FFID) Al Maftul:** (TRA Level 4) PTT met with LTC [redacted] and discussed station operations. PTT then surveyed the AO for familiarization.

**(TA0056) Balad District HQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT made contact with GEN [redacted] and the Sheiks concerning the IP that was in jail. They said the IP was a hero and they would meet with him next Wednesday about the matter. An inspection was made of the jail which was clean and inmates were in good physical condition.

**(TA 0810) Hay al Askari IHP:** (TRA Level 3) PTT met with the IHP and IP at this combined station. CF and PTT conducted training for the IP and IHP on how to properly search a

vehicle for contraband and explosive devices. Additionally, the CF built a total of five targets for the range.

**(TA0047) As Zewiah:** (TRA Level 3) PTT spoke with the station commander, CPT [redacted], who stated that his training officer is LTC [redacted] and that, according to his records, all IP are current in their training. CPT [redacted] stated that his station is in need of weapons, ammunition and ballistic barriers. The CPT stated that the station has been attacked four times in the last month with RPG's and rockets. No injuries were reported and attempts to retaliate against the attackers have met with negative results. CPT [redacted] provided PTT with a copy of his request to Bayji DHQ for the items he feels he needs to properly defend his station and surrounding community.

**(TA0050) As Saniyah:** (TRA Level 3) PTT met with Chief [redacted] and he stated that things were going very well with his station. Chief [redacted] said 7 IP and CF were on a mounted patrol last night when they were attacked with an IED. He advised that there were no injuries or significant damage. Chief [redacted] stated he had IP manning a checkpoint, on station security and some were training in a class on handgun maintenance.

**(TA0075) Massahag:** (TRA Level 3) PTT spoke with Station Commander, LTC [redacted] who stated that this station had been attacked several times in the past month and that the station was in need of a PKC and sandbags for roof top fortifications. LTC [redacted] was told that this request would be forwarded through PTT and that he needed to also make a request through Bayji DHQ.

PTT also visited the main station and spoke with the Station Commander, LTC [redacted] who said that he was appreciative of the equipment provided by the PTT, but that his station was in need of weapons and ammunition. LTC [redacted] has requested these items from Bayji DHQ. The LTC stated that LTC [redacted] is his training officer and that his personnel were trained to standards. The LTC stated that any further training needed would be handled at the Tikrit Academy.

**Mosul (MND-N)**

**Ninewah**

**(NO FFID) 5<sup>th</sup> Emergency Response Battalion:** (TRA Level UNK) PTT traveled to the 5<sup>th</sup> ERB and conducted firearms training with five ERB instructors. Topics were firearms safety, stance and moving and shooting. The Civilian members of the PTT learned upon arrival that due to the absence of civilian PTT members from previous day, the trainees were allowed to leave station for five days off.

**(NO FFID) FOB Q West:** Training for 15 IP was conducted at FOB Q-West on Police Ethics and Community Policing.

**(MN0004) Bi'aj DHQ:** (TRA Level 3) Bi'aj DHQ PTT visited Al Gazira LPS and Al Aboor LPS to inspect operations. At Al Gazira LPS, there were six IP. PTT was told the chief and executive officers were both in Sinjar. None of them were left in charge. They did not have enough personnel to conduct a patrol. PTT left an information poster about handling IEDs and a note for the training officer. The note outlined suggestions and goals, which PTT hope to implement.

At Al Aboor, PTT held two separate meetings. The meeting with the Assistant Station Trainer, Haythum Hussein Ahmed, covered the same goals and expectations as the note

previously mentioned. These suggestions were gleaned directly from the Police Station Monthly Report, so that the LPS may put their training programs on track to success. PTT then conducted a joint dismounted patrol in Al Aboor and gave away a box of toys, which were donated by a Non-Commissioned Officer's family.

**(MN0016) Al Kisik LPS:** (TRA Level UNK) PTT traveled from FOB Sykes to Al Kisik LPS without incident. When PTT arrived at Al Kisik the IP's were bringing in two detainees for fighting in a nearby neighborhood. As PTT spoke with LTC [redacted] an IA unit arrived and went back out to the same neighborhood with an IP patrol. When they returned they had six more detainees in custody. The reason for their arrest stemmed from a continuation of the initial conflict. All detainees were from the same tribe. LTC [redacted] stated they would see the Judge tomorrow if they were unable to work the problem out before then. PTT returned to FOB Sykes without incident.

**(MN0056) Ninewah Provincial Headquarters:** (TRA Level 2) PTT spoke with BG [redacted] and his command staff. The meeting entailed preparations for the upcoming meeting with several members from CPATT. The details of the meeting are not definite and subject to change before the meeting.

In MPSA class 24, there are 151 students, from the Mosul area. MPSA Class 25 continues with 236 students from Tall Afar and 53 from Mosul. The Police Station Training Officer Course began on this date. The class has 21 officers from the Mosul area.

**(MN0066) Sinjar DHQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT traveled to Sinjar DHQ for the purpose of meeting with LTC [redacted] (XO) in reference to logistic issues. PTT also met with Intelligence Officer LTC [redacted], who informed PTT of a possible terrorist attack in Biaj area. LTC [redacted] said he received information four days ago from IP in Mosul regarding terrorist launching an attack for the purpose of controlling Biaj area. LTC [redacted] said the possible attack is supposed to occur within Ramadan and the actual date is unknown. LTC [redacted] also mentioned the village of Domese is in the open and has no force protection around it. LTC [redacted] requested a force protection be built around the village of Domese to protect the citizens. PTT concluded the station visit and traveled to the Mayor Office for a 10:00 a.m. meeting.

PTT arrived at the Mayor Office and met with Mayor [redacted], City Counsel Chief Ways, Sinjar DHQ LTC [redacted], IA Intelligence Officer LT [redacted] IBP LT [redacted] JCC SGT MAJ [redacted] and Peshmerga Intelligence Officer Nathem Aebayr. The purpose of the meeting was to talk about the intelligence gathered and prepare for any future attacks in the area. IA mentioned of a terrorist attempting to attack the Izidy citizens and kill as many as possible during Ramadan. IA had a concern about a Judge releasing terrorist after being paid off by terrorist. Mayor will check into other cases and see which Judge is corrupt. IA solution to protecting the citizens is to do as much patrols in each village and drive terrorist out by showing a show of force. PTT concluded the meeting at the Mayor Office and then traveled to Bulayj.

PTT arrived in Bulayj and met with CPT [redacted] CPT [redacted] said his SGT MAJ had his weapon (Glock) confiscated when he was traveling through Peshmerga checkpoint. CPT [redacted] said SGT MAJ was off duty and refused to leave his ID when going through Peshmerga checkpoint to enter a village. CPT [redacted] said he sent several IP to retrieve SGT MAJ weapon from Peshmerga and were told by Peshmerga the weapon had to be picked up from the Peshmerga Commander. CPT [redacted] said SGT MAJ was also assaulted by Peshmerga security forces. PTT advised CPT [redacted] to notify LTC [redacted] at DHQ and make him aware of the incident.

PTT also met with Sheik of a nearby village who use to be anti CF. Sheik responded by saying, he later learned that CF was here to help the Iraqi people. Sheik gave PTT information (specific information withheld). The Sheik said his life is being threatened and is requesting police protection and security for the Mosque on Friday, 21 September 2007, from 1200 – 1300 hours. The Sheik said there are weapons in the Mosque for the purpose of protection. PTT completed the station visit and returned to Nimur. PTT then traveled to FOB Sykes.

**(MN0076) Tal Afar DHQ:** (TRA Level 2) PTT visited Tal Afar DHQ and met with BG [redacted]. Several topics were discussed including the continuation of the Basic Police Skills course for those who have not yet been to the academy and the status or Ramadan security. PTT also spoke with lead investigator LTC [redacted] reference the status of terrorist cases from MTU. LTC [redacted] stated that he has completed thirteen cases to the satisfaction of MTU liaison COL [redacted] and forwarded same. He is continuing to work on additional cases which have been brought to his attention. There were reports that a citizen upset with treatment by Iraqi Police Special Forces attacked a checkpoint with SFA although this could not be confirmed at this time. No injuries were reported. Prior to the attack, the suspect had a meeting with BG [redacted] and complained that an IJ wanted him to sign a statement and sent IPSF to his home twice for the signature. Both times he refused and felt that he was being harassed.

**(MN0099) Major Crimes Unit/ Major Terrorist Unit:** (TRA Level 2) PTT met with COL [redacted], commander of MCU, and discussed the criminal cases MCU is investigating. COL [redacted] advised no new cases has been transferred to MCU in the last week. COL [redacted] did advise that the Judge determined there was a lack of evidence to convict COL [redacted] commander of Intelligence, of the recent terrorist charges filed on 22Aug07. This criminal case is now closed with no further investigation anticipated. PTT was advised the only case remaining against COL [redacted] is one filed by COL [redacted] commander of Internal Affairs. COL [redacted] accuses COL [redacted] of providing a list of high ranking IP officer names to the terrorist. COL [redacted] advised there is no evidence to prove who passed out this list of names and the complaint should have never been made.

COL [redacted] also informed PTT that the MCU vehicle that was destroyed by a CF tank sometime ago has still not been replaced. COL [redacted] advised he needs that vehicle just as soon as he can get it. PTT advised COL [redacted] that CF had approved a vehicle replacement more than a month ago, and would make contact with LT [redacted] to find out what the current status is, as well as try and find a target date COL [redacted] can expect to get the new vehicle.

PTT met with COL [redacted], commander of Intelligence. COL [redacted] advised he is still waiting for the criminal charges to be dropped against him so he can resume normal duties as commander of Intelligence. COL [redacted] advised he continues to command his unit to the best of his ability while these false allegations are being investigated. COL [redacted] feels certain he will be vindicated very soon.

**(MN0134) Abu Maria LPS:** (TRA Level 3) PTT met with SGT [redacted] who stated the IA and Coalition Forces conducted a joint raid in Al Mazraa Al Raba AO. The IA did not inform or include the LPS IP about the raid. SGT [redacted] conduct a roll call with the IP every two days. PTT suggested the IP shift leaders keep a log book of the activity in the AO. PTT spoke to LTC [redacted] about having regular meetings with the local village sheiks and leaders, to provide a better working environment and create a safer AO. LTC [redacted] said he is still not being paid and hopefully his pay will come, next month. PTT taught a class, on PMI. PTT then conducted a joint mounted patrol.

**(MN0201) Ninewah SWAT:** (TRA Level UNK) PTT had a meeting at NPHQ to obtain approval to conduct a four day training session of Ninewah SWAT personnel on FOB Marez. Permission was granted and the training is scheduled to begin (date withheld). PTT also met with SWAT LT [redacted] and turned over contractor bid sheets for the estimates of repair work at the SWAT compound. LT [redacted] will have the bids for PTT by the end of the week.

**(MN0928) Abi Tamaam DHQ:** (TRA Level 2) PTT conducted a foot patrol with the IP in the Al Shorta neighborhood. PTT observed IP interacting with the community. PTT also conducted Operation Good Neighborhood. PTT, along with IP, made contact with the children in the neighborhood and passed out toys and school supplies. IP also made contact with the citizens in the neighborhood. IP were very receptive and productive with the operation.

**(MN0962) Al Salaam LPS:** (TRA Level 2) The PTT mission was travel to Al Salaam LPS and meet LTC [redacted] concerning security preparedness for Ramadan and to gather information about ACF activity. LTC said he was waiting for a source to confirm information that a house IED had been planted in his district. LTC stated that the house IED was narrowed to three homes, but was waiting for the confirmation. PTT advised LTC to notify IA and JCC immediately and dispatch his IP to the location to cordon the area. LTC contacted his source and met PTT at the station. The source stated that the house IED was believed planted at his home, which he vacated earlier after ACF ordered him to leave. At the scene, PTT, IP, and IA were joined by the MTT and EOD who later arrived. After the home was secured and neighbors relocated, the house IED was removed by EOD and destroyed by water shot detonation.

**At Tamim** [redacted]

**(TT0023) Azadi Patrol Police Station:** (TRA Level 2) PTT met COL [redacted]. Several matters were discussed and PTT obtained an organizational chart of the station officers and their duties. PTT conducted a check of the station's detention facility, noting eight detainees. The detainees appeared cared for with proper cell ventilation, lighting and bathroom facilities. The detainees did not appear mistreated and complained of no mistreatment when asked.

**(TT0025) Qoria Patrol Police Station:** (TRA Level 1) PTT met with COL [redacted]. Several matters were discussed including a lack of office supplies. PTT conducted a check of the detention facility and noted it to be the cleanest, most well ventilated and well lit such facility yet seen in country.

**(TT0034) Kirkuk Training Center:** (TRA Level 1) PTT met with COL [redacted] and took part in the weekly staff meeting. COL [redacted] informed PTT that he has received ammunition from headquarters. Per COL [redacted] he received 150,000 AK-47 rounds, 30,000 PKC rounds and 30,000 9mm rounds. COL [redacted] said this is not enough ammunition to properly conduct

firearms training at the academy. CPT [redacted] the firearms instructor, said he is taking two different classes to the range within the next 48 hours. They will only be able to shoot twenty AK-47 and ten 9mm rounds. All agreed that this is not proper firearms training and only a familiarization fire. COL [redacted] said he will request more ammunition through headquarters. COL [redacted] said city power is still working on the transformer project and will be done sometime this week. COL [redacted] advised that the academy will conduct a basic reading and math class for active duty IP who are lacking in these areas.

**(TT0099) Kirkuk Major Crimes Unit:** (TRA Level 2) PTT worked on emergency action plan and prepared for validation of the plan.

**(TT0616) Laylan District Police HQ:** (TRA Level 2) PTT performed PSMR data collection and observed a shift change.

**(TT0910) Aydallah Patrol Police Station:** (TRA Level 1) PTT spoke with the training officer about the classes he has started giving. He advised PTT that the IP were in full attendance. PTT also visited the detention room. The detainees looked healthy and there appeared to be no human rights violations.

**Irbil**

**(NO FFID) Koya Crime Combat:** (TRA Level 3) PTT visited MAJ [redacted] at Koya Crime Combat and obtained the MGRS for the station. MAJ [redacted] was in the process of interviewing one of eight persons in connection with robberies in Koya. PTT discussed the request for fingerprint equipment and learned that the request was sent in, but no response has come back to date. Upon further discussion, PTT discovered the request with suggested justifications had only been sent approximately 4 days ago. MAJ [redacted] advised PTT that he would call when the reply to his request comes in.

**(MI0049) Communications Center:** (TRA Level 3) PTT met with LTC [redacted] at the Communications Center and discussed the radio equipment and the convoy that was attacked while attempting to travel to Baghdad to pick up the equipment. The commander advised PTT that the convoy was attacked two times while in route to Baghdad. This is the second unsuccessful attempt to pick up this equipment. The commander advised PTT he had two officers wounded and lost two vehicles. The commander requested, once again, that PTT assist them with any means available to deliver the equipment. PTT advised the commander that any personnel who attempted to transport the equipment would most likely be the target of an attack. PTT further advised the commander that CF was giving the equipment to the KRG and that they would most definitely have to arrange the transportation to the region. There are no other known options.

**(MI0070) Shorsh Degala Patrol Police Station:** (TRA Level 3) PTT visited the Shorsh Police Station and was notified that the station commander was attending to other matters in the district. The Force Protection Detail was noted to be fully staffed and in place, despite the physiological impositions of observing Ramadan. PTT queried the FP detail as to responses they would mount to various attack scenarios, and they appeared to be well versed in this area.

**MI0606 Irbil Crime Lab:** (TRA Level 3) PTT traveled to the Irbil Crime Lab to conduct training on the proper formulation and usage techniques of Ninhydrin development solution. PTT was informed that MG [redacted] was still in Sulaymaniyah and may return in a few days.

**Sulaymaniyah**

**(NO FFID) Sulay PJCC:** (TRA Level UNK) PTT met with BG [redacted] and discussed PJCC operation. BG [redacted] advised that there were no major incidents over night and that PTT should start receiving emailed reports soon. PTT spoke with BG [redacted] and [redacted] regarding the bi weekly meeting at the MOJ and they showed interest in attending these meetings. PTT advised that they were welcome to attend.

**(NO FFID) Sulay Police College:** (TRA Level UNK) PTT provided IP training in the subject matter of fingerprints.

**(TS0015) Barda Qaram LPS:** (TRA Level 3) PTT traveled to Barda Qaram and conducted the new DRS with the Station Commander, LTC [redacted]. PTT observed the detention areas and no persons were in these areas. The cells were clean and very neat. PTT also conducted class on "Foot Print Casting" for the Station.

**(TS0020) Bazyan LPS:** (TRA Level 3) PTT continued with the investigation class at this location covering Criminal Sexual Assault/Conduct.

**(TS0034) Dukan DHQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT traveled to Dukan DHQ and conducted the final day of a one week community policing training program for the remaining fourteen of the 24 IP who originally began the training. PTT presented a compact disc to one representative from each station involved in the training which contained the course curriculum and pictures that were taken during the course of the training. A graduation ceremony was conducted and certificates of completion were presented to the fourteen IP who successfully negotiated the course. Also presented was a certificate of appreciation to the district commander for his willingness to participate in the Community Policing Program.

## Dahuk

**(MD0002) Dahuk Provincial HQ:** (TRA Level 3) PTT met with MG [redacted] about the items in the warehouse in Mosul. PTT questioned the MG as to his intent on these items. He stated he would be willing to send a convoy to pick these items up; however he would have to coordinate it thru the IA in Mosul. MG [redacted] was given a list of the items awaiting pickup. PTT also discussed plans to build a new eight bay facility to handle vehicle repairs for the province. PTT explained to the MG that the training will possibly held in Mosul. He stated the mechanics would most likely not be willing to travel to Mosul for the training due to security reasons. PTT is attempting to determine where and when the training will exactly be held.

**(MD0005) Khabat LPS:** (TRA Level 3) Community Policing class continued to be taught by LT [redacted] at Khabat LPS. PTT is monitoring and assisting him with his first class on this subject. The LT began by reviewing the principles and benefits of community policing along with methods of introducing this concept to the local villagers. Following this, he used examples of how community policing can enable the police to respond to a call and sometimes prevent an incident or to keep it from escalating into a more serious situation. The class then visited a local village where the students spoke with shop owners, individuals in the marketplace, and residents. This was an exercise to improve their skills in forming a relationship with their local population.

While training was being conducted, an additional 13 IPs were registered into the BATT system. The Team inspected the generators at the ERU Compound. None were operating at the time. A schedule on the times of operation was from 0900 to 1800, and from 2000 to 0700. The generators were never started while the PTT Team was at Camp Charlie.

**FOB DELTA:** 4 IPAs were scheduled for a total of 5 PTT Missions. One PTT mission was cancelled by military personnel. All additional PTT missions were completed with out incidents. Remaining IPAs not on mission assisted with the Crucible CLS Academy Training Class.

**(BW0034) Wasit Checkpoint Headquarters:** (TRA Level 2) PTT spoke with Lieutenant Colonel [redacted], [redacted] is assigned to the Inspections Unit based at Provincial Headquarters. His unit is in the process of conducting a complete inspection on the checkpoint. This unit's responsibility involves checking weapons, personnel, buildings, administration, equipment and all other pertinent items. He said his completed report would be turned over to the new General. [redacted] said complete inspections were being conducted on all facilities within the province. It is estimated this will take approximately 2 months.

**(BW0605) Wasit Iraqi Highway Patrol:** (TRA Level 2) PTT members met with all of the IPs and Officers on duty at Wasit HPHQ. They related that they were very upset because of a letter from PHQ stating that Colonel [redacted], the station commander, was to be removed and reassigned. The IPs further advised if this should happen, they would refuse to come to work. The Team advised them that they would look into the matter. While at the station, a remote control robot was demonstrated and an Army Medic treated four IPs for various non work related minor ailments.

**(BW0600) Wasit Internal Affairs:** (TRA Level 2) PTT spoke with Lieutenant Colonel [redacted], who had just been appointed commander by MOI a few hours prior to our arrival. His previous assignment was Commander of the Criminal Investigations Division. LTC. [redacted] knew very little about the exact details of the office, but said he would be well informed by the next coalition visit.

**(BW0601) Wasit Patrol Police Station:** (TRA Level 3) PTT convoyed to the Wasit Province Vehicle Patrol Police Station and met with the administrative officer, Captain [redacted]. PTT learned from Captain [redacted] that there were 34 patrols conducted today. Captain [redacted] explained that it is his job to make sure all reports are in order and sent up to Provincial Headquarters. Captain [redacted] also keeps copies and records of all reports at the station. Caprain [redacted] stated that around 2:30AM, City Councilwoman [redacted] was at her home when an IED exploded under her vehicle in her driveway. There were no injuries, but the vehicle was destroyed. No arrests were made and the incident is still under investigation. Captain [redacted] also stated that Major [redacted] has been putting out vehicle descriptions to his IP's on patrol as an exercise and, so far, the IP's have been finding the vehicles in question. It should be added that PTT also learned that over the last 2 months, 2 IP patrols from this station have been fired for suspicion of being militia members or supporters.

**(BW06012) Wasit EOD Unit:** (TRA Level Unknown) Wasit EOD mission was cancelled due to the Diablo 2 element being moved to QRF at the last minute.
