(BC0003) Airport Police Local Police Station: The Station Commander (Colonel [redacted]) requested that no training be conducted on Fridays or Saturdays. IPs investigated the accidental death of a worker which occurred on June 7th at the BIAP. Information revealed the deceased was employed with the SATCO construction project currently underway at the BIAP. The Team assisted the SATCO Project Manager with obtaining information concerning release of the body. The Team observed the morning Guard Mount and found IPs ready for duty. The Team continues to monitor IP's daily performance at the Terminal and French Village Sub-Station.

(BC0009) Al Alawiyah Local Police Station: The Team met Colonel [redacted] (Station Commander) who advised the AOR had been quiet during the past 48 hours. He advised the Station has 1 AWOL who will be dealt with accordingly. The Team conducted 1 Joint Patrol with 4 IPs occupying 1 vehicle. The patrol visited the location where IPs and the IA had previously fired shots at 4 fleeing suspects. Preliminary information indicated the suspects were occupying a vehicle which failed to stop at a Checkpoint. The vehicle eventually was stopped and the suspects (wearing uniforms similar to NP clothing) fled on foot. 1 suspect was captured and a search of the vehicle revealed a kidnapped victim inside the trunk. The victim had been beaten and was transported to a local hospital.

Force Protection manning was inspected and found to be adequate. Contractors are upgrading the guard towers and the construction is being monitored by the Teams' Military counterpart.

(BC0012) Al Dorah Patrol Police Station: The Team met Major [redacted] (Shift Commander) and discussed Station operations. No Training was conducted due to all available personnel being on assignment.

(BC0018) Al Jazaer Local Police Station: The Team conducted Training for 8 IPs and 1 Officer covering Static Checkpoint Procedures. Special emphasis was placed on officer safety as IPs practiced setting-up 2 checkpoints and searching vehicles. The Team conducted 2 Joint Patrols with 8 IP and no incidents were experienced. The Team met Lieutenant [redacted] (Shift Commander) and discussed Station operations.

(BC0021) Al Kadhimaya Local Police Station: The Team visited the Station and found no IPs available for Training or Joint Patrols.

(BC0023) Al Kadhimaya Traffic Police Station: The Team met Lieutenant Colonel [redacted] (Station Commander) and discussed Checkpoint operations in the AOR. The Team recommended implementation of a log-book system at each Checkpoint to provide documentation of events and intelligence information. The importance of passing-on information to other personnel at Checkpoints was stressed relating to officer safety. Lieutenant Colonel [redacted] embraced the idea and stated he planned to implement the change as soon as possible. Intelligence information revealed JAM meetings are becoming frequent at Boratha Mosk which is located near the intersection of Grizzlies and Dodgers.

Additional information indicated IEDs and VBIEDs are on the increase in the areas of Route Irish/Arrows and Huskies Bridge near Route Senators. The kidnapping of an IA officer in Kadhamiya District was reported and the crime was thought to have been staged in order to bolster the importance of IA presence in the area.

The Team visited the Station and found the Command Staff investigating 2 VBIEDs which were detonated in the AOR. Reports indicated a 3rd VBIED (filled with rockets) was disarmed and no further details were available concerning the incident.

(BC0041) Al Mesbah Local Police Station: The Team conducted 1 Joint Patrol and Foot Patrol with IPs handing out information flyers to the public. The Team inspected the Detention Facility and found 389 detainees incarcerated in stifling hot conditions. The Station does not have power for air-conditioning or fans. The Station is receiving vehicle fuel and IPs will not travel to Al Dora Station for generator fuel. The Station is in compliance with the MOI AWOL Policy and warning flyers are posted in clear view on the walls.

(BC0042) Meshahadah Local Police Station: The Team conducted Training for 11 IPs covering Patrol Principles/Objectives and VBIED Reaction Procedures. Lesson plans were reviewed with an IP instructor. The Team inspected Force Protection and found it to be adequate.

(BC0043) Al Muthana Local Police Station: The Team conducted Training for 2 IPs and 1 Officer covering Handcuffing Prisoner Transport Procedures. The Team conducted 1 Joint Patrol with IPs and no incidents were experienced. The Team inspected the Detention Facility and found 39 detainees incarcerated with no problems reported. The Rusafa Corrections Facility continues refusing to admit prisoners. The Team met Lieutenant Colonel [redacted] who expressed concern over the lack of information provided by the JSS. The Team encouraged him to continue efforts working with the JSS. Intelligence information was obtained from 3 IPs concerning the operation of a terrorist cell by foreign fighters in the AOR. The information was passed to the JSS for whatever action deemed appropriate.

(BC0049) Al Rashad Local Police Station: The Team met Captain [redacted] (Shift Commander) who stated there was no IPs available for training. The 4 IPs previously reported AWOL at New Baghdad JSS have not returned to duty and their status is unknown. The Station Commander was not available due to attending a meeting with Coalition Forces.

(BC0081) Bab Al Sheikh Local Police Station: The Team conducted Training for 2 IPs covering Vehicle Search Techniques. The Team conducted 1 Joint Patrol and 3 Foot Patrols with IPs and no incidents were experienced. The Team inspected the Detention Facility and found 37 detainees incarcerated with no problems reported.

(BC0100) Mada'in Patrol Police Station: The Team conducted Training for 3 IPs covering High Risk Vehicle Stops and Routine Vehicle Stops. Students were attentive to the material presented and participated in practical exercises to demonstrate proficiency. The Station has 25 AWOLs and their termination process has been initiated. The Team is monitoring the process and will provide follow-up information as necessary.

(BC0122) Sheikh Saad Local Police Station: The Team conducted Training for 4 IPs and 1 Officer covering Situational Awareness. Lieutenant [redacted] (STO) assisted with presenting the class. The Team inspected the Detention Facility and found 4 detainees incarcerated with no problems reported. Fans were in use for detainees inside the detention area. The Team met Colonel [redacted] (Station Commander) who advised MOI orders were

received directing that IPs are not allowed to possess cell-phones while conducting patrol duties.

Babylon (MND-CS/S) [redacted] (b)(3), (b)(6)

No information received from FOB Delta at the time of this report.

Babil Province [redacted] (b)(3), (b)(6)

(BB0032) Babil Provincial HQ: No missions were conducted by IPLOs assigned to FOB Kalsu. However, training was conducted at the FOB Kalsu Training Facility. Twenty-one IPs received an eight hour block of instruction on AK-47 and 9mm handling. The IPs were then taken to the range and conducted live fire training with both weapons.

Dhi Qar / Al Muthanna (PIC) [redacted] (b)(3), (b)(6)

PTT members attended the daily operational briefing in Camp Terendak and also attended the daily MTT/CPATT meeting in MAJ [redacted] office.

PTT members attended the Weekly Targeting Conference (replaces the weekly planning conference) for OBG (W) 3 activities in Al Muthanna & Dhi Qar Provinces in the near future.

PTT members were tasked to research subject matter for upcoming Training classes that PTT will conduct at the Al Muthanna IPS Academy in the future. Subjects tasked include Basic Crime Scene Investigation, Human Rights, Community Policing as well as Instructor Training.

Tikrit (MND-CW) [redacted] (b)(3), (b)(6)

No report on this date from Diyala Provincial assets which is due possibly to the Chlorine VBIED attack that occurred on June 3rd. Internet service is inoperable at this time.

Salah Al Din [redacted] (b)(3), (b)(6)

(TA0139) Salah Al Din ERU 1st Battalion: PTT met with the ERU Chief and several contractors from three different companies to assess damages and to plan repairs for the building. The walls around the perimeter of the building need to be modified with added height to provide better security. Two towers added to the top of the roof were also discussed. The contractors will provide an estimate and bid for the improvements within a few days.

(TA0084) Samarra District Police HQ: PTT met with GEN [redacted] who stated that he had some of his men assisting the IP at BP 4 since they were once again, short handed. PTT

also learned that there might have been as many as 825 IP paid during this pay period. This number appears to be very high and the Team is still researching where this money has ended up. PTT will attempt to find out what happened to the payroll and what amount of money was refunded back to the PHQ in Tikrit.

GEN [redacted] continues to state that there is more National Police coming and they will be able to assist in securing Samarra. There have been very few patrols in the city by IP due to the absence of the National Police. According to GEN [redacted] GEN [redacted] has been asked to supply additional IP. PTT still does not have visibility of these additional NP. MAJ [redacted] advised PTT that the 60 IP that COL [redacted] is in the process of hiring, should arrive tomorrow. PTT will be able to supply them with uniforms and vests, but there are no duty boots to issue. PTT advised both GEN [redacted] and MAJ [redacted] to send a request to GEN [redacted] to see if new boots could be procured.

(TA0087) Thar Thar Station Local Police Station: PTT met with LTC [redacted] and explained to him that the Team is going to be gathering up 27 AK47's along with several PKC Rifles. The weapons will be taken back to the JCC to secure the weapons, as they are losing IPs at an alarming rate. The Team explained to him that if the IP return to work or the station gets more IPs, then the weapons will be brought back. LTC [redacted] appeared to agree with this.

PTT was advised that there was a total of 36 IP now at the station and there were 11 IPs and 1 officer on-duty during the PTT visit.

(TA0074) Makhul Police Station:

PTT visited the Makhul Police Station. While at the station, PTT spoke with COL [redacted] who advised that everything was proceeding well in regards to the station. He advised that he had 9 IP report to duty on this date and a total of 41 IP at his station. He also advised he was able to get 10 new IP and they were working well. CF issued the station one filing cabinet, two gallons of paint, and some paint supplies. No classes were conducted during this visit.

(TA0077) Highway North Police Station:

PTT visited the Highway North Police Station. During the visit, the PTT spoke with COL [redacted] and he advised that the station and the village were doing well. He advised that he had 20 IP report to duty on this date and had a total of 77 IP at his station. CF issued three gallons of paint and paint supplies to the COL. No classes were conducted during this visit.

(TA0050) As Saniyah Police Station:

PTT visited the station and no IP's were available for training.

No training was conducted today. All teams were in planning meetings for the upcoming week.

(MN0056) Ninewah Provincial Headquarters: PTT was unable to visit the headquarters as the military members of the team stood down for vehicle maintenance.

(MN0224) Tal Uwaynat Local Police Station: PTT visited the Tal Uwaynat LPS and conducted a station assessment and inventory for the PSMR. PTT made recommendations for each deficiency found. PTT was advised that the railroad plans to tear the LPS down when the new train station is complete. It appears the construction is nearing completion.

(MN0076) Tall Afar District Police HQ: PTT did not visit station this date, due to military re-tasking.

At Tamim

(TT0099) Kirkut (Tamim) Major Crimes Unit (CID): PTT assisted the Major Crimes Unit with the release of one prisoner from FOB Warrior. PTT inspected the Investigators' room and found that it had been rearranged and cleaned. LTC [redacted] and PTT discussed the organizational structure that will be proposed to COL [redacted] next week.

(TT0910) Aydallah Patrol Police Station: PTT convoyed to Aydallah Police Station and met with 1SG [redacted]. 1SG conducted a Shift change formation and had an inspection of necessary equipments for all IP.

(TT0022) Meghdad Patrol Police Station: PTT convoyed to Meghdad Police Station, met with the Shift Supervisor 1SGT, and visited the holding cell with six inmates and were all doing fine with no medical issues.

(TT0024) Qarah Anir Patrol Police Station: PTT convoyed to the Qara Hinjeer IP Station. Upon arrival, the team made contact with the shift commander, LT [redacted]. The team held a training session for ten of the IP. Training was conducted in searching vehicles and persons.

(TT0027) Rashad Patrol Police Station: Extended Visit:

June 3rd: PTT arrived at Rashad Police Station and met with the shift commander. PTT discussed the fact that Rashad IP had been seen on TCP operations without CF or IA support and emphasized that the IP were not to conduct such acts without CF or IA support. Discussion was made concerning that there were some IP at the station who were acting in collusion with insurgent forces.

June 4th: PTT went to Rashad Police Station and met with CPT [redacted]. PTT again discussed the issues of IP conducting TCP operation without CF or IA support. PTT also delivered a large chest freezer to the station along with ammo pouches for the IP. CPT [redacted] said that he and the station chief were upset because the station was not receiving the number of new IP from academy as had been originally planned. The station will receive only ten of the 30 new IP promised.

June 5th: PTT went to Rashad Police Station and conducted a foot patrol throughout a section of the village of Rashad. Afterwards, the participating IP asked questions pertaining to the patrol and other theories of foot patrol were discussed. PTT took photos and fingerprints of the station IP by use of the BAT system.

June 6th: PTT went to Rashad Police Station and met with the station commander. PTT checked the IP weapons, ammo, and ID cards. PTT requested that the IP keep records of logistical issues, such as fuel, etc., and also requested to be informed of travel of IP to attain more fuel.

June 7th: PTT went to Rashad police station and met with the commander, the Mayor, IA commanders at Rashad, and CF officers. The mayor complained that there was a lack of

electrical service and water in the area and requested assistance from CFs to remedy the situation.

(RA0013) Fallujah District Police HQ: The Police Transition Team began training the new class for the Provincial Support Unit.

(RA0032) Karmah Patrol Police Station: No station visit was conducted. Military PTT members were assigned to non PTT related missions.

(RA0060) Saglawiyah Patrol Police Station: The Police Transition Team continues to provide training to the new warrant officers in supply accountabilities and hand receipts. Iraqi Police conducted six patrols independent of Coalition Forces today. The warrant officer in charge of Operations has developed and implemented an effective routine for pre-patrol briefings and inspections.

The Police Transition Team mentored the warrant officer in charge of Logistics. This Iraqi Police Warrant Officer is currently conducting a station-wide inventory to include vehicles, weapons, equipment and station appliances. The mentoring process initiated this week has worked very well with this Warrant Officer who is proving to be very efficient in the supply logistics area.

After conducting a thorough vehicle inventory, the station was found to have eleven vehicles assigned. Four trucks are mission capable, four are in need of repair located at Camp Fallujah, one truck destroyed by an Improvised Explosive Devise and is located at Fallujah District Headquarters, Navel Criminal Investigative Service has impounded one vehicle as evidence at Camp Fallujah and one vehicle is currently missing.

Note: The Station has no effective command structure and is in need of experienced Iraqi Police Officers in key leadership positions.
