**(BC0011) Al Dorah PS:** Training was conducted with 15 IPs on force protection and weapons safety.

**(BC0016) Habibya PS:** The generator at the station has been repaired but is only being utilized for a few hours at night to conserve fuel. The metal security gate is in need of repair and a bid of \$200 US to complete the work has been obtained from a local contractor.

**(BC0028) Al Karkh Directorate HQ:** COL [Redacted] advised that he is in need of an additional 7,000 round of ammunition for his PKCs and has submitted the request. He is also requesting smoke grenades, flash bangs, sand table, weapons rack, uniforms (100 sets), mattresses (75) and breaching equipment. COL [Redacted] had not submitted requests for these items and was mentored on completing the proper paperwork so that team members could monitor the progress.

**(BC0037) Al Kahdra PS:** Training with 30 IPs was conducted on community policing and patrol techniques. The body of an IP was brought into the station with a gunshot wound to the head. No further information was available.

**(BC0038) Al Khansa PS:** The station had 52 IPs on duty with 32 assigned to patrol, 12 to force protection and eight to admin duties. A joint patrol was conducted without incident.

**(BC0039) Al Mamum PS:** Station construction projects are nearing completion with the resurfacing of the inner compound parking lot and seized vehicle storage areas in their final stages. Training on active shooter and ambush reaction (C6) was conducted with six IPs.

**(BC0047) Al Quds PS:** The shortage of fuel was a main topic as the station continues to have problems in this area. Major [Redacted] said that General [Redacted] from Rusafa HQs told him that if fuel is needed, they should take up a collection from the IPs and buy it. This is an ongoing problem and needs to be addressed at higher levels. Team members would like to send the investigators to some training but with there being only two assigned to the station that is not possible at this time. Major [Redacted] has sent requests to Rusafa HQ to have more assigned but gets no response.

**(BC0060) Al Shulla PS:** Team members are still attempting to ascertain how many IPs have received training and what level of training they have had. The station currently has no master trainer or training records. The detention cell currently has 42 prisoners but is only large enough to hold 20 at most. The station is currently allotted 19 vehicles but there are only nine assigned to them, all in working order. Force protection appears to be adequate.

**(BC0064) Al Taji PS:** Team members conducted a recruiting drive at the station with 56 candidates being accepted after providing the proper identification and other paperwork. PTT delivered 5,000 rounds of ammunition.

**(BC0085) Baghdad PHQ:** PTPP mentored COL [Redacted] and COL [Redacted] on a possible Community Affairs program that they could use.

**(BC0090) Boob Al Sham PS:** COL (b)(7)(c) advised that, with the help of the IA, a number of roads on the south side of the city had been closed off. These roads were being used to avoid the main highways and checkpoints. The hope is that this will improve the effectiveness of the checkpoints and prevent some IEDs and VBIEDs from entering the city.

**(BC0092) IHP HQ:** Team members met with the training section and went over the results of yesterday's training exercise. The shortcomings and strengths were discussed. The training section had several good ideas to address the deficiencies and develop a training plan as such. The team will continue to closely monitor the trainers and assist in anyway possible. A class on spreadsheets and database management was given to two members of the training section.

**(BC0093) Hy Al Amil PS:** Training was given to 12 IPs on self defense, proper interview stance, contact cover, person searches and human rights. The stations training officers have been giving weapons safety training on days when the team isn't there.

**(BC0095) Jisr Diyala PS:** The Station Commander has appointed three IPs to be the stations trainers. Team members met with them and discussed their responsibilities and the upcoming training that they will be given in preparation to start training the other IPs.

**(BC0096) Karada Miriam LPS:** Training was conducted with five IPs on high risk vehicle stops and first aid.

**(BC0110) Al Nasir PS:** The station is in need of radios and reports a shortage of body armor. Training was conducted with nine IPs on preparation of an incident report.

**(BC0112) New Baghdad PS:** The station is in need of Glocks and 9mm ammunition for the new recruits. The station is going to receive 50 new AK47s and ammunition for them. COL (b)(6) has issued a no parking or stopping ordinance for vehicles in the market areas.

**(BC0117) Risalah PS:** The armory was inspected with all weapons accounted for; however there were unauthorized personnel in the armory and the weapons weren't cleaned properly. A night patrol was conducted without incident.

**(BC0119) Rusafa PS:** Team members observed the IPs and IA involved in a SAF battle with insurgents in the Sheik Umar neighborhood. Team members noted that the IPs failed to use cover properly or good team tactics.

**(BC0120) Rusafa Directorate HQ:** PTT met with Major (b)(6) who was dealing with a complaint that alleged that an IP stopped a female and took her passport. PTT informed the Major about the allegation that they received with regards to a logistics officer selling department owned ammo to IPs. The Major requested that the PTT have the IP make a formal complaint.

Team members met with COL (b)(6) about a report they received about him not issuing out supplies that were recently delivered. The COL indicated that he has decided not to issue any supplies or equipment until after internal affairs completes their audit of the facility.

**(BC0122) Sheikh Saad PS:** Preparations were made to have T barriers placed around the new fuel pods. COL (b)(6) is going to appoint an IP to be in charge of fuel accountability and has outlined the procedure for that position. The station is still understaffed. Training was conducted with five IPs on curfew enforcement including vehicle and foot patrols and field interviews.

**(BC0625) Mahmoudiyah PS:** An IP has reported that his mother, brother and six year old nephew were abducted by men displaying MOI badges (commandos he called them), approximately a month ago. Since then the IP has received three calls, one from his brother's cell phone, demanding money. He has also given detailed information including vehicle descriptions and location and names of a group of approximately 30 men who are reportedly involved in kidnappings in the area. The IP also stated that he went to on Baghdad area PS to report the incident but saw one of the kidnappers there and so he left, when he went to another station, they refused to take the report. The IP is also worried that if a certain official at the Mahmoudiyah Patrol Section finds out that he is reporting this, he will suffer harm.

## An Najaf

**(RN0005) Traffic DHQ:** PTTD traveled to Traffic Substation Median. This Substation is located within the traffic circle named Revolutionary Circle. PTTD conducted training on Temporary Traffic Checkpoints to fifteen IPs.

**(RN0011) Haydariya PS:** PTT administered a class to 10 IP's covering the basic use of the handheld radio, as well as OPSEC measures. The Major advised he has 6 inmates in the D-cell. They were all observed and appeared to be in good health.

**(RN0633) Manathera DS:** Training was conducted on the escalation of the use of force.

**(RN0802) Patrol DHQ:** PTTD trained 7 IP's in weapons safety and weapon malfunctions. The team utilized a graduate of the train the trainer program to assist in teaching the class.

**(BB0030) Ash Shomali PS:** The station currently has 96 IPs assigned with approximately 50% needing academy training.

**(TD0026) Hibhib PS:** PTT conducted a DSR visit for the station. The Station Commander advised that the station's number of personnel remain at sixty-eight. The Commander also stated that they have a vehicle that is in need of repairs. There have been no attempts to have the vehicle repaired, through the proper requests. Additionally there have been no attempts to repair the backup power generator or to any of the areas within the station that are in need or repairs.

PTT reports that they have mentored the Commander numerous times on the proper procedure for requesting repairs or funds for repairs. The Commander has indicated to the PTT that he will not follow such procedures when it would be much easier for CFs to provide him with the cash to do what he has to do. PTT will forward this information to the PTTT to be dealt with at the PHQ level.

**(TD0031) Jedidah PS:** The station reports having one hundred twenty five IPs assigned. Four IP have been scheduled for training at the Baghdad academy in July and a total of eight are in need of academy training. The Commander advised that the station has been issued four vehicles. Three are operational, one is not. The non-operational vehicle has a broken fuel pump. The Commander is purchasing the part out of his own money and having the IPs under his command repair the vehicle. PTT assisted with the delivery of a new power generator. PTT observed the station during an emergency drill. The drill demonstrated the preparedness of the IPs to an attack.

**Salah Ad Din** \_\_\_\_\_

**(TA0080) Tikrit PHQ:** PTTP visited the detention facilities on FOB Danger beginning with the Community Crimes Section. One inmate was being held awaiting trial. He stated that all other prisoners left about 15 days ago. He is suspected in the kidnapping of a contractor. Both the detaining and Section OIC stated that the victim's family will come to the jail in a matter of days to determine if they want to press charges. The prisoner stated that he had been struck on the feet with a police baton and pointed to places on his ankle as if to indicate bruising, but no visible bruising was present. There were no other signs of abuse at the prison. The prisoner claimed he is well fed.

The Chief informed the PTTP that 6 men were assigned to his detention center and all from different departments. He also stated that he is allocated two guards per shift that are filled by the emergency company.

PTTP visited the Important Crimes Detention Facility. There were 8 detainees awaiting trial for aggravated crimes such as murder and robbery. There were 42 detainees waiting trial for lesser crimes. Of the 42 detainees, 30 were IPs who had been locked up by General \_\_\_\_\_ for being involved in a fight. They are all due to be released in 2 days. There were no signs of abuse. The detainees stated that they have been treated humanly and are well fed.

**(TA0084) Samarra DHQ:** The PTTD conducted a joint check point. The IPs operated and conducted vehicle searches, along with checking occupants inside the vehicles while PTT observed and conducted security for the checkpoint. IP's conducting checkpoint needed little guidance.

**(TA0087) Thar-Thar PS:** PTT observed the IPs at a flash checkpoint noting that they did well. PTT conducted range training with the IP Officers. The focus of the training was safety and discipline.

**(No FFID) Dijhlay PS:** PTT observed the station during a simulated attack on the station noting that the IPs performed much better than the previous training exercise. PTT conducted training in the areas that they felt the IP's were deficient in based on their observations. PTT was informed that LTC \_\_\_\_\_ had not prepared a list of names to be sent to the academy and that an IP who was recently released from jail for allegedly making IEDs has return back to work. PTT will look into the matter of the IP further.

**Camp Paliwoda:** PTT went to FOB Rock to observe training; the classes instructed were firearms safety and maintenance, and firing techniques. PTT met with LTC \_\_\_\_\_ who informed the PTT that an IP was going to be charged for wasting 500 rounds. The IP in question wasted the rounds shooting at a wild pig.

## At Tamim

**(TT0023) Azadi PS:** COL [Redacted] (b)(7)(c) requested assistance in installing the razor wire that was delivered. This wire is to be added to the perimeter security wall for increased security and make this a "GO" situation. PTT mentored the station's armorer on how to develop a weapons cleaning program.

**(TT0005) Kirkuk PHQ:** PTTP was informed that approximately 30 days ago, 4 vehicles (2 Durango's and 2 pickup trucks) from FOB Warrior were delivered to General [Redacted] (b)(6) by unknown CFs and that allegedly two of the vehicles were sold to a local contractor named [Redacted] (b)(6).

## Mosul (MND-N)

## Ninewah

**(MN0201) Ninewah SWAT:** The SWAT team participated in a three day sniper over-watch with CF in two locations, which were selected due to the high density of IEDs placed on the roadways on recent dates. Throughout the entire operation swat operators participated in every facet of the over-watch. During this mission swat operators were mentored in; assigning QRF, communications with ISF, secondary over-watch procedures, medical evacuation procedures, approach and exit routes, GPS waypoints, ROE, logistical support planning, house clearing and security, watch scheduling, action and procedures on contact, and after action review.

**(MN0381) Al Zuhoor PS:** PTT met with LT [Redacted] (b)(7)(c) and talked with the Al Zuhoor Command Staff regarding the level of force protection for the new station and their lack of utilization of the force protection materials provided. There are currently twenty two prisoners in the jail, of which two were arrested yesterday for making and placing IEDs in the Al Zuhoor district. The team used this as an opportunity to provide training to the IP Investigators in interview and interrogation techniques. The subjects were interviewed with the guidance of the PPT.

**(MN0076) Tall Afar DHQ:** Discussions were held with Major [Redacted] (b)(7)(c). The Major spoke about various needs at the Kisik station to include doors, windows, fans, air conditioners and some basic logistical needs. He also discussed the need for an additional checkpoint in the area with the necessary T-walls and jersey barriers.

An incident was reviewed that involved a prisoner taken to Mosul from Hassenqoi station and subsequently found to have injuries upon arrival at that location. Mosul refused to accept the prisoner. Pictures of the injuries were reviewed along with some basic facts. General [Redacted] (b)(6) advised that the incident is under investigation and the results will be provided upon completion. The team conducted computer training to the IP assigned to the Operations Room.

**(MN0220) Al Karama DHQ:** PTTD conducted a station assessment. PTTD responded with the Al Karama IPs to a call about a body being found on the roadway. PTTD observed that upon arrival the IPs had established a crime scene perimeter and checked for possible IEDs, noting that the IPs did an excellent job of securing the crime scene and checking for other threats in the area.

**(MN0008) Al Gizlani PS:** PTT mentored Major [Redacted] (b)(7)(c) about IPs receiving salaries without reporting to work.

**(MN0962) Al Salaam PS:** PTT met with LT [redacted]. He informed the team that all the electrical issues at the station have been resolved without any support from HQ or CFs. LT [redacted] stated that the Commander had arranged it with liquid funds of his own.

**(MN0020) Hassenqoi PS:** This station is implementing an additional checkpoint in their AO, which will provide another view of an area with high level of insurgency activity. A nineteen year old prisoner from the jail was transported to Mosul yesterday for interrogation due to the fact that he was thought to be a juvenile. Mosul authorities rejected him and sent him back to Hassenqoi. Somewhere during the return trip he alleges that he was tortured by the IP's that transported him. He showed marks that appear to be human bite marks on his upper arms and legs, and a small cigarette burn on the upper part of his hand. An investigation was ordered by LT [redacted]. The incident was reported to the PTT team for notification to the PHQ. There are currently 37 prisoners incarcerated in the jail, which is significantly more than there is adequate space for. The IP jail supervisor asked if they could utilize the other room that is currently being used as storage. He was referred to LT [redacted]. The station reported they have sufficient food and water.

A computerized personnel data sheet complete with photo is ongoing. All of the IP's on this shift have been photographed except for those manning checkpoints. General [redacted] visited the station with the intention of finding out what their needs were. He became involved in the prisoner abuse allegation. He was also informed of the shortage of fuel. PTT provided training to the IP Sergeants on pre and post patrol briefings. The team also conducted two joint vehicle patrols.

**(MN0022) Al Rabaein DHQ:** The team discussed the plans for providing security and searching the Al Songh neighborhood. The team monitored the IP's search operation, and then met with COL [redacted].

**(MN0214) Al Waqaas PS:** PTT met with the Station Commander and discussed means of increasing force protection at the station. PTT provided the IPs with weapons cleaning equipment and conducted a course of instruction on weapons maintenance. The team recommended to the Station Commander to add an operations and radio room to the station. PTT observed a prisoner being struck with out cause and reported the incident to the IPs supervisor and then instructed the IP on the appropriate use of force.

## Arbil

**(MI0001) Arbil PHQ:** PTT met with General [redacted] to work out a training schedule that would not hinder patrol operations. General [redacted] assigned LT [redacted] to work with the PTT. LT [redacted] stated he would be able to supply 50 personnel for the Sulaymaniyah class on 25 Jun 08. However, could not supply 100 for the Arbil TIP class. PTT reminded the LT that MOI Sinjari and CPATT Command Staff had agreed on specific numbers. The issue was not resolved.

**(No FFID) Arbil Security DHQ:** PTTD conducted training for students attending the Advanced Special Weapons and Tactics Course.

## Sulaymaniyah

**(No FFID) Asaish Main HQ:** The team conducted sniper marksmanship training, for ten designated SWAT snipers.

**(No FFID) Crimes and Evidence Directorate:** PTT asked Major Qadar about the computer equipment that was being obtained for the new "Evidence Collection Technical" class. Major [redacted] showed the team a new computer and printer for the class and a digital camera that will be coming in the near future. Major [redacted] and his Commander will purchase the equipment since no CFs money or equipment is being provided to the Kurdish region.

The team provided a course of classroom instruction on basic evidence collection process. The class consisted of four areas of basic evidence collection, proper clothing to reduce contaminating the crime scene with alien materials, communicating with the first officer on the crime scene, initiating proper procedure to processing the crime scene, and developing a game plan to process the crime scene. PTT team offered suggestions on how to construct this equipment out of local materials from the local market. Materials are also being donated from police and sheriff station in the US for the Evidence & Crime Station.

## Dahuk

**(MD0002) Dahuk PHQ:** Information was obtained for updating the PSMR. PTTP provided Captain [redacted] with a list of the KPs which had completed the M&M test yesterday. PTTP was informed that intelligence from Arbil indicated that there was a possibility of five young females coming to Dahuk, driving a Mercedes Benz and that they posed a threat for a VBIED or an IED attack. There are 102 detainees in the jail, all waiting to see the Judge. The facility is clean and the detainees appeared to be in good shape. A doctor comes to the jail twice a week to deal with any medical concerns. The KPs are still asking for vehicles, weapons, ammunition and the other items CFs has promised them. The team provided range training with the AK-47 to fourteen KP and fifteen Asaish at Camp Zawita.

**(RA0080) Al Quaim DHQ:** PTTD accompanied the pay officers to the Al Qa'im bank in an attempt to have the paycheck cashed. When they arrived it was determined that they could not cash it due to improper "payee" on the check. PTTD brought the pay officers to Camp Al Qa'im for further transport to Fallujah, and will attempt to rectify the problem with a trip there.

The station is constantly going through changes, a contractor came today to assist in clean up around the station, but was told to come back tomorrow due to the pay call. The electricity comes from the local grid and continues to be spotty. The generator is still inoperative, due to no fuel or money, information relayed to the PTTP that O&M funds were on the way. The water is operational again after repairs made to the pipes PTTD is in the process of improving the force protection problems and rectifying the generator and water problems.

**(RA0110) Rawah DHQ:** Rawah has 42 IPs. Rawah is rated for 180 IPs and is currently well under their allotted numbers. Future IP screenings are being addressed with the military. The payroll for the IPs arrived yesterday and was distributed to all IPs that were at COP Rawah. Continued efforts by the military are in progress to locate the other IPs to dispense their payroll.

**(BQ0029) Qadisiyah PHQ:** PTTP members met with General [Redacted] along and General [Redacted]. The team discussed the current situation with the training at the Al Kut Academy. It was decided that the 58 recruits remaining would stay at the Academy until General [Redacted] travels there to meet with General [Redacted] and General [Redacted]. General [Redacted] is to assess the situation, then make the decision to either withdraw the students or allow them to remain. The IPs that left due to the conditions will be allowed to be placed in the next BPA class.

**(BQ0610) Hamza DHQ:** PTTD met with LTC [Redacted]. The DHQ has 20 IP's who have received phase one academy training. LTC [Redacted] stated that he has made several requests for vehicles, radios, and ammunition to the PHQ and feels like he is getting no cooperation from them. LTC [Redacted] also complained about the facilities, stating that he needed a new police station because the current one floods in the winter and the sewage backs up. The team explained to the commander that they would speak with the PTTP and ask for their assistance.

**(BQ0021) Hamza PS:** The team met with Major [Redacted] who requested vehicles, radios and ammunition. The station has 139 IPs of which 70 have been to an academy.

**(BQ0037) Sudayr PS:** The team met with Major [Redacted]. There are 80 IPs, who have all been to the academy. There is daily training being conducted at the station. Major [Redacted] advised the team that he was in need of radios, vehicles and ammunition. The station only has a total of 1,500 rounds of ammunition available. There is a Mahdi Militia office directly behind the station. The commander stated there have been no problems with the militia.

## Wasit

**(BW0047) Wasit Police Academy:** PTT mentored and gave class room instruction to 17 IPs from Wasit Investigation. Ninety three IPs tested and passed the M&M testing.

## Basrah (MND-SE)

**(BE0600) Auxiliary Police:** PTT met with Colonel [Redacted]. COL [Redacted] has recently taken command of the Auxiliary Department. The decision to place COL [Redacted], (who was previously head of Sector Four of the IPS) into this position is seen as a potential opportunity to make positive changes in this unit. This unit has been the subject of allegations of serious breaches of law and has lacked the public trust in the past.

**(BE0015) Al Hadi PS:** The Al Hadi Police Station was stormed by twenty five armed men from the Thar Allah Islamic Party to free three male detainees that had been arrested from a shoot out during a CSU operation three months ago. The IP's were overrun and surrendered the prisoners to the armed men. The IP's were not forthcoming in releasing the names of the released prisoners. The assailants who attacked the station were dressed in a commando style uniform. No casualties were reported.
