(11) (U) **RUF for Detainee Operations.** TAB C are general rules for the use of force in detainee operations. TAB D are the rules for use of force in detainee operations involving the Mujahideen-el-Khalq (MeK). These RUF are consistent with these ROE, but take into account the unique operational requirements for US military police and security units that transport, hold, and detain detainees.

a. (U) Warning shots are normally aimed shots or bursts into a safe backstop. They may be used as a signal to an element that does not yet qualify as hostile (a positively identified hostile force, those who commit a hostile act, or those who display hostile intent), but that is potentially hostile.

c. (U) Disabling Shots as an Alternative to Warning Shots. If you have positively identified that vehicle occupants are hostile you may fire a disabling shot instead of a warning shot. A disabling shot or burst is fired with the intent of stopping the vehicle. Normally, disabling shots with motor vehicles are into tires or the engine compartment.

(16) (U) Commander, MNC-I is responsible for establishing training materials for rules of engagement training. Commander, MNC-I will issue the MNF-I standard for text to be used on rules of engagement training cards for land operations, as well as ROE training vignettes and slides.

(16) (U) In order to ensure consistency of the ROE throughout the operational area and in situations where units from different commands operate across areas of operation, commanders of MNF-I direct subordinate commands must submit a copy of any rules of engagement orders that they issue to the MNF-I Deputy Chief of Staff, Strategic Operations. Address a copy of these reports to the OSJA, Operations Law Division, by electronic means. All requests for supplemental ROE measures will be routed in this manner.
