1. (U) **SITUATION. Change.**

1.A. (U) This order promulgates CDR USCENTCOM (Ref C) and CDR MNF-I approved ROE ISO continuing U.S. military operations in Combined Joint Operations Area (CJOA) Iraq as MNF-I OIF ROE authorization Serial Two. Previously issued MNF-I OIF ROE serials and modifications are rescinded. U.S. Forces are in Iraq, at the request of the Government of Iraq (GoI), to assist with the maintenance of security and stability in Iraq. This order provides U.S. Forces in Iraq with ROE necessary for the conduct of military operations pursuant to the U.S.-Iraq Security Agreement (SA) (Ref D).

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3.D.1.L. (U) **Personnel Recovery Operations.**

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3.D.1.M. (U) **Definitions.**

3.D.1.M.1. (U) **Collateral Effects.** Collateral effects as they relate to Computer Network Attack are further defined in Ref X to Ref C. For the purpose of 3.D.1.E. above, No and Low Collateral Effects are defined as follows:

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3.D.1.M.6. (U) **High Payoff Target (HPT).** A target whose loss to the enemy will significantly contribute to the success of the friendly course of action. HPTs are those High-Value Targets (HVT) that must be acquired and successfully attacked for the success of the friendly commander's mission.

3.D.1.M.7. (U) **High Value Target (HVT).** A target the enemy commander requires for the successful completion of the mission. The loss of High-Value Targets would be expected to seriously degrade important enemy functions throughout the friendly commander's area of interest.

3.D.1.M.8. (U) **Hostile Act.** An attack or other use of force against the United States, U.S. Forces or other designated persons or property. It also includes force used directly to preclude or impede the mission and / or duties of U.S. Forces, including recovery of U.S. personnel or vital U.S. Government property.

3.D.1.M.9. (U) **Hostile Intent.** The threat of imminent use of force against the United States, U.S. Forces or other designated persons or property. It also includes the threat of force to preclude or impede the mission and / or duties of U.S. Forces, including the recovery of U.S. personnel or vital U.S. property.

3.D.1.M.10. (U) **Imminent Use of Force.** The determination of whether the use of force against U.S. Forces is imminent will be based on an assessment of all facts and circumstances known to U.S. Forces at the time and may be made at any level. "Imminent" does not necessarily mean immediate or instantaneous.

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3.D.1.M.14.A. (U) **Riot Control Agents.** Any chemical, not listed in a schedule of the Convention on the Prohibition of the Development, Production, Stockpiling and Use of Chemical Weapons and on their Destruction which can produce rapidly in humans' sensory irritation or disabling physical effects which disappear within a short time following termination of exposure. Also called RCA.

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3.D.1.N. (U) ALL Major Commands.

3.D.1.N.1. (U) Ensure all military operations within CJOA Iraq are conducted in accordance with these ROE.

3.D.1.N.2. (U) All commanders will ensure their personnel are familiar with the Law of War and with these ROE.

3.D.1.N.3. (U) If operationally required, commanders will promulgate additional ROE and / or amplified ROE guidance applicable to forces under their command and submit them via the chain of command to the next higher commander for review and / or approval pursuant to guidance contained in Ref C. Commanders will ensure that modified or supplemental ROE:

3.D.1.N.3.A. (U) Remain compatible with the intent of these ROE.

3.D.1.N.3.B. (U) Result in more definitive guidance to subordinate commanders.

3.D.1.N.3.C. (U) Do not impair the commander's inherent right of self- defense.

3.D.2. (U) This FRAGO contains enduring guidance and will be included in future drafts of the EXORD / Command Policies and Procedures. **Cancelled Measures.** All previous issued OIF ROE serials, modifications and ROE specific guidance are rescinded.
