





MEMORANDUM FOR SA (b)(3), (b)(6) AFOSI EDET 2408, Baghdad, Iraq

SUBJECT: IED attack on Strategic Counter-Intelligence Directorate (SCID) personnel on 20 FEB 2006

1. On 20 FEB 2006, at approximately 0945 hours local, a suspected improvised explosive device (IED) detonated at (b)(2)High next to a U.S. convoy that was transporting SCID personnel, DANIEL J. KUHLMEIER and (b)(3), (b)(6), in Baghdad, Iraq. KUHLMEIER was killed in the attack and (b)(3), (b)(6) sustained severe facial injuries.
2. CEXC was not requested to conduct a post-blast analysis of the scene until approximately 2 weeks after the incident. By that time, the blast scene was compromised. Any items of evidentiary value had been lost.
3. The limited evidence which was recovered in this matter is insufficient for CEXC to assess the type of device used in this attack.
