

Ms. Linda Norgrove Recovery Chronology

Event

08 OCT 10 20:07:33	An armed insurgent (EKIA3) emerges from one of the southern buildings (25) dragging/pulling Ms. Norgrove behind him. They were quickly followed by a second insurgent from the same building (25). The second insurgent (EKIA2) moved quickly past them on the trail in front of the building and headed towards a terrace in front of buildings 21, 22, 23 where the assault force was clearing and is engaged and falls at the front right southwest corner of building 23.
08 OCT 10 20:07:43	As Ms. Norgrove is being dragged by the insurgent, she stumbles, falls, and is quickly pulled back to her feet. The insurgent continues to drag/pull Ms. Norgrove down the path towards the assault force on the terrace in front of buildings 21, 22, 23.
08 OCT 10 20:07:53	As the insurgent rounds a tree at the NW corner of building 25, heading East up the path running between building 25 and 23, Ms. Norgrove is positioned slightly behind the insurgent and to his left.
08 OCT 10 20:07:57	As the insurgent reaches the stairs at building 23, members of the assault force engage him simultaneously from two areas: the terrace in front of building 22, and the roof of building 23 respectively. The insurgent falls several feet back down the path and stairs intersection between building 23 and 25. In the process, Ms. Norgrove also falls and rolls into a position at the corner of building 25 next to the insurgent (EKIA3). No one on the assault force sees or hears Ms. Norgrove throughout this engagement.
08 OCT 10 20:08:08	A member of the assault force, having seen three armed insurgents all emerge from the same direction and assessing that there is a continued threat from this area, throws a fragmentation grenade towards the path between building 23 and 25 where EKIA2, EKIA3 have been engaged and Ms. Norgrove is laying unseen.
08 OCT 10 20:08:13	The grenade explodes probably near the upper left torso and arm of EKIA3, flipping him over and moving him several feet further down the slope. It is likely that Ms. Norgrove was hit by shrapnel and/or debris in her back, neck and head.
08 OCT 10 20:09:03- 20:12:29	The assault force continues to clear and secure the objective, efforts concentrated on buildings 11 and 12 where Ms. Norgrove was suspect to be being held. EKIA's were not checked in this phase and Ms. Norgrove had not been seen or heard.
08 OCT 10 20:17:49	Multiple assault force team members converge on Ms. Norgrove's location. The immediate surrounding Ms. Norgrove is checked for munitions, and medical assessment is immediately conducted. No vital signs were detected during the assessment. Medical personnel conducted life saving measures; however, her medical condition was determined to be "expectant," which meant that her wounds were so extensive that her survival was unlikely. In the absence of a medical doctor's examination, she could not be formally pronounced deceased. Ms. Norgrove is then prepared for extraction.
08 OCT 10 21:31:30	Ms. Norgrove is lifted from the extraction point and taken aboard a helicopter for recovery to Jalalabad Airfield. The assault forces were subsequently extracted on a subsequent helicopter.
08 OCT 10 21:48:00	Ms. Norgrove arrives at Jalalabad Airfield and is pronounced deceased.

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09 OCT 2010	Ms. Norgrove is transported to Bagram Airfield for formal identification and a death certificate is issued.
14 OCT 2010	Ms. Norgrove is repatriated to the United Kingdom through Royal Air Force Station Lyneham, UK.
