Subject: Building 570 Injury

Sir,

At approximately 1442 hours, (b)(6), who works for Clark Construction fell off the top of the roof and/or crane and struck the ground below. There were several large lacerations and opened fractures on his head, arms and knees, though was conscious at the time when transported by ambulance to Tampa General.

Information is limited at this time due to the individual being in critical condition and was transported to Tampa General at 1705 hours.

A review of the CENTCOM security cameras does show this occurrence from a distance. The attached photo shows the location. He fell from the location of the Cherry Picker, however the video is not really very clear and he does not appear to be in the cage but walking around it.

Mr. (b)(6) our safety officer is aware and will be starting the investigation in the morning. I will update you as we learn more.
