Gents,

Wanted you to know the Lt Col (b)(6) , a nurse from CCSG, witnessed and was one of the first responders to the accident that happened last evening. She observed the worker fall from the top of the new CENTCOM building, made her way to him on the construction site and administered first aid until emergency services arrived. I would assume that someone might want to discuss what happened with witnesses and LtCol (b)(6) . Additionally, she spent some significant time working with the patient and she is very concerned for his welfare, does anyone have an update on his status in the hospital. It's amazing he had survived the fall and he did have a severed leg and other serious injuries but was conscious and able to communicate while being treated.
