At or about 1645, 14 July 2010, I departed Building 540 through the back entrance next to the Café and proceeded down the ramp with a full view of the incident site. I looked up and noticed three construction personnel on top of the roof of the new USCENTCOM Building. Two of the three workers were further up the roof and one worker was on the edge of the roof with one hand on the Lift basket. I looked back down at the ground and heard somebody holler out from the roof where the workers were located. I looked back up and saw the worker that was on the roof/Lift fall and hit the ground. I ran into Building 540 to the Security Desk and told the Security personnel "Get an Ambulance, a worker fell from the roof of the new building." I waited until the Base Police and Medical personnel arrived then I departed.
