



PRECAUTIONS

Safe Transportation of Household Chemicals and Electronics

- Avoid placing chemicals in the passenger compartment of your vehicle. Transport items in trunk or rear of your vehicle in sturdy boxes/containers that can be thrown away. Boxes may be lined with kitty litter.
- Do **NOT** mix materials.
- Label all containers.
- Bring products in their original containers.
- Ensure containers are not leaking.
- Do **NOT** put chemicals in your vehicle until ready to take to the collection. Open a window while driving to the collection site.

A Substance is Hazardous if it is:

- **Toxic:** directly or indirectly poisons living things.
- **Ignitable:** capable of catching fire.
- **Corrosive:** capable of chemically eroding another substance such as cloth, metal or skin.
- **Reactive:** capable of participating in a chemical interaction or transformation.
- **Carcinogenic:** capable of causing cancer.

If Improperly Disposed of, Hazardous Products can:

- Cause a fire or release toxic fumes.
- Pose a health risk for collectors.
- Contaminate the groundwater supply and the environment.
